"This is an Operation Iraqi Freedom Investigation"

This office was notified by Mortuary Affairs, Mosul, that the remains of an Iraqi detainee had been delivered by 67th Combet Support Hospital (CSH) persoanel.

Investigation disclosed Mr. State Was detained by the personnel and subsequently interrogated. During the morning of 5 Apr 04, Mr. State Was allowed to sleep and when checked by Navy corpsmen was found to be unresponsive. Magnetic was transported to the 67th CSH where he received emergency medical care. Mr. Was unable to be revived and subsequently died of unknown causes.

On 26 Apr 04, an autopsy of the remains of Mr. Was conducted by LTC (Dr.)

USAF, Deputy Medical Examiner, Office of the Armed Forces Medical Examiner (OAFME), Armed Forces Institute of Pathology (AFIP), Rockville, MD. Database related the cause and manner of death were both undetermined with no obvious signs of a homicide nor of a satural death.
