 - -Nothing new revealed, but 15 vague incidents forwarded to CID for clarification
- -Other notables
 - -FBI released documents ambiguous

Review of DODGC provided documents

- 16,000 pages (not including Regs/Directives)
 - Identified 316 documents (38 incidents) for add'l review
 - 46 Documents determined no further action
 - 4 had insufficient info for further action
 - 270 Docs (15 incidents) being clarified w/CID
 - 43 Add'l Documents related to GTMO

- -Army CID HQ has directed reviews of all detainee abuse cases:
 - -With named subject, or
 - -Detainee death
- -VADM Church Investigation reviewed 356 CID/NCIS cases involving detainee abuse
- -Coordinating w/BG Furlow's current SOUTHCOM investigation
