This is an "Operation Iraqi Freedom" investigation.

This investigation was initiated based on a Memorandum of Transmittal 0041-04-CID789 from the Prisoner Interview/Interrogation Team (PIT), 75th Military Police Detachment (CID) (-) (FWD), Baghdad Central Confinement Facility (BCCF), Abu Ghraib, IZ which related their office interviewed Mr. [REDACTED] b7c-1, b6-1, b2 whom alleged he was abused while detained at the Baghdad Airport, Baghdad, IZ.

Investigation established the offense of Cruelty and Maltreatment did not occur as alleged by Mr. [REDACTED]. This was verified through a previous interview of Mr. [REDACTED] and a medical screening, which stated his injuries were not consistent with his alleged abuse.

DETAILS

BASIS FOR INVESTIGATION: On 26 May 04, this office was notified by LTC [REDACTED] b7C-3, b6-3, Joint Interrogation Debriefing Center (JIDC), Baghdad Central Confinement Facility (BCCF), Abu Ghryeb, Iraq (AGI), that Detainee [REDACTED]; National Detainee Reporting System (NDRS) [REDACTED]; Baghdad, Iraq; reported he was physically abused by US Forces while at Dhyla Al Mokhadia Base, Iraq.

About 1310, 26 May 04, LTC [REDACTED] b7C-3, b6-3 provided this office with a medical screening of Detainee [REDACTED] b7C-3, b6-3, written by CPT (DR) [REDACTED] 202nd Military Intelligence (MI) BN (USAF), BCCF, AGI, detailing the abuse allegations. (See Medical File)

About 1500, 27 May 04, SA [REDACTED] b7C-1, b6-1, with the assistance of Interpreter [REDACTED] b7C-3, b6-3, this office, interviewed Detainee [REDACTED] about the alleged abuse. He related that he was captured by US Forces on 9 Apr 04 near Baghdad and was taken to Dhyla Al Mokhadia Base east of Baghdad. He said this location was an Iraqi Civil Defense Corp (ICDC) location. He said he was there for three days with his hands tied, eyes blind folded, with no food or drink before he was transported to the airport in Baghdad. He was held at the airport until four days ago when he arrived at Abu Ghryeb. He said while at the ICDC location, two people, an English speaking male and an Arabic speaking male, took him to a small room and made him lean against the wall with his eyes covered and his hands tied behind his back. While he was leaning against the wall, the English speaking person would kick his feet and legs. He said he was hit in the head and back with an unknown object. He said this happened every time he was interrogated over the three days. He then showed this agent marks on his back which appeared to be several healed parallel scratches.

At this time, this agent recognized the marks as well as the detainee from a prior occasion. This detainee was processed a few days before while this agent was present. An unknown Military Police (MP), at the front entrance, discovered the marks, while a search of the detainee was being conducted. The MP brought the marks to this agent's attention. This agent asked the detainee what happened to his back. Detainee [REDACTED] related they were from a car accident. This agent advised the detainee the marks looked like whip marks and asked again what the marks were from. Detainee [REDACTED] related once again the marks were from a car accident. This agent asked a third time what the marks were from and if had been abused in anyway. Detainee [REDACTED] b7C-4, b6-4 replied that he had not been abused and the marks were from a car accident.

AGENT'S COMMENT: Detainee [REDACTED] b7C-4, b6-4 could not write Arabic well; therefore a verbal statement was taken.

AGENT'S COMMENT: On the day in question, this agent made note of the marks and the detainees response and requested the written note be placed in the capture file. It is unknown at this time whether the note made it to the capture file. Also when Detainee [REDACTED] was confronted with his previous explanation of the marks. He said he had never seen me before and had a slight smile on his face. His reaction led this agent to believe Detainee [REDACTED] b7C-4, b6-4 was being deceptive.

About 1540, 27 May 04, SA [REDACTED] b7C-1, b6-1 requested SSG [REDACTED] b7C-4, b6-4, 428th MP Co., BCCF, AGI, who was present on the day Detainee [REDACTED] b7C-4, b6-4 was asked about the marks, determine Detainee [REDACTED] b7C-4, b6-4 was the same detainee from four days prior. He recalled seeing the detainee and the issue with the marks. He recalled this agent asking the detainee three times what the marks were from. He recalled the detainee replying they were from a car accident. SSG [REDACTED] b7C-4, b6-4 agreed to provide a sworn statement. (See Sworn Statement)

AGENT'S COMMENT: Detainee [REDACTED] b7C-4, b6-4 reaction, when confronted with the discrepancies, and his deceptiveness led this agent to believe Detainee [REDACTED] b7C-4, b6-4 was fabricating the alleged abuse in an attempt to receive early release and/or monetary restitution.

About 1300, 29 May 04, SA [REDACTED] b7C-1, b6-1 coordinated with 1LT (DR.) [REDACTED] b7C-3, b6-3, 391st MP BN Aid Station, BCCF, AGI, and requested a complete medical physical be conducted on Detainee [REDACTED] b7C-4, b6-4. (See Physical Report)

About 1555, 30 May 04, SA [REDACTED] b7C-1, b6-1 interviewed CPT [REDACTED] b7C-4, b6-4, who provide a sworn statement detailing the allegations made by Detainee [REDACTED] b7C-4, b6-4. CPT [REDACTED] b7C-4, b6-4 also provided photographs, which he exposed of Detainee [REDACTED] b7C-4, b6-4 alleged injuries. (See Sworn Statement and Photographs)

On *[REDACTED]* Detainee *[REDACTED]* was searched for contraband upon entering the Holding Area. During the search scars and red marks were found on his back. CID Agent asked the detainee what had happened to his back. The detainee responded with, it was from a car accident. Agent *[REDACTED]* asked three times are you sure, it was the same response. During questioning on 05/27/04 the detainee decided that he had been beaten. I was called in to verify the detainee, to insure he was in fact the same one. At first sight I knew it was him. The marks on his back were still there and I have seen nothing of that nature since.

I, [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-4 want to make the following statement under oath: I am making this statement freely.

On 25 May 2004 I talked to a 21 year old detainee NDRS # [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-4 who came to me for routine medical screening to determine if he was medically fit to undergo interrogation. During the course of the evaluation, the patient reported 46 days prior experiencing physical abuse while at "Ohyla Al Mokhdadia base. The patient stated the abuse occurred at the "I.C.D.C. building" and reported that the abuse was by "American soldiers". The patient reported that part of the time his eyes were covered and his hands were cuffed. He stated that food and water was withheld from him for three days. He stated that he was kicked in the head and back. He stated that he also had his feet stepped on. His exam showed multiple linear scars on his back. Pictures were taken of the back findings. He also complained of a headache and pain from a prior chronic knee injury. After my exam, it was determined he was fit for interrogation. He was given Tylenol for as needed headache relief, and discharged to the Vigilant prisoner camp.

Q: Were the injuries consistent with his allegations of abuse?

A: The marks on the back do not look like kick marks.

Q: How recent do you believe the marks were?

A: They could be 6 weeks old.

A: They appear to be healed abrasions and contusions.

Q: Do you have anything to add to this statement?
