INVESTIGATIVE SUMMARY:

This is an "Operation Iraqi Freedom" Report of Investigation.

This office was notified by the Staff Judge Advocate, Camp Iron Horse, Iraq APO AE 09323, of an Assault and Communicating a Threat against an Iraqi detainee.

Investigation established probable cause to believe LTC [REDACTED] committed the offense of Communicating a Threat when he charged his 9mm pistol, positioned it threateningly during his interrogation of Mr [REDACTED] and related he would kill Mr [REDACTED] if he did not provide the appropriate information.

Investigation further established probable cause to believe LTC [REDACTED] committed the offense of Aggravated Assault when LTC [REDACTED] placed the head of Mr [REDACTED] into a clearing barrel, while interrogating him, and fired his 9MM pistol near Mr [REDACTED]'s head.

Further, investigation established probable cause to believe SPC [REDACTED], PFC [REDACTED] SPC [REDACTED], SSG [REDACTED] and Ms [REDACTED] committed the offense of Assault when they punched and kicked Mr [REDACTED] numerous times while they were interrogating him.

Investigation failed to prove or disprove SPC [REDACTED] and SFC [REDACTED] committed the offense of Assault.

DETAILS

BASIS FOR INVESTIGATION: About 2100, 19 Sep 03, this office was notified by the Staff Judge Advocate, Forward Operating Base (FOB) Iron Horse, Tikrit, Iraq APO AE 09323 of an Assault and Communicating a Threat against an Iraqi detainee.

About 1000, 20 Sep 03, SA [REDACTED] advised LTC [REDACTED] 2/20th Field Artillery Battalion (FA BN), FOB Gunner, Taji, Iraq of his rights, which he waived and provided a sworn statement in which he confessed to Assaulting and Communicating a Threat toward Mr [REDACTED]. Detainee Number [REDACTED], Baghdad, Iraq (NFI). (See Waiver Certificate and Sworn Statement for Details)

About 1445, 25 Sep 03, SA [REDACTED] and Mr [REDACTED] Interpreter, Titan Corporation, 4th Military Police Company, FOB Iron Horse, Tikrit, Iraq, interviewed Mr [REDACTED] who provided a verbal statement in which he stated on 20 Aug 03 he was detained by United States Military personnel while he was working as a police officer at a local Iraqi Police Station in Taji, Iraq. Mr [REDACTED] stated he was transported to a Military Detention Facility and placed into a private room where he sat for approximately one hour. When the hour passed two soldiers placed him into a different room and started to interrogate him. The two personnel were female and one sounded Egyptian. The Egyptian lady would translate for the other female. As the interrogation proceeded the Egyptian lady stated to him that she would kill him if he did not talk, then she proceeded to kick him in the right leg. About thirty minutes later LTC [REDACTED] arrived and as he entered the room he chambered a round in his 9MM pistol and placed it on his lap with the barrel of the weapon facing Mr [REDACTED]. As LTC [REDACTED] was doing this a soldier pulled his shirt over his head and numerous others soldiers began to punch him in the chest. He stated he received bruises on his ribs, but they have since healed, however, he still had trouble breathing. He further stated he could not see how many soldiers were hitting him because his shirt was over his head. Mr [REDACTED] stated the only thing he knew about the soldiers striking him was they entered the room with LTC [REDACTED]. When he still would not provide information, LTC [REDACTED] and the Egyptian interpreter took him outside and showed him six soldiers standing in line with their weapons in hand. The Egyptian interpreter then stated, "If you don't talk, they will kill you". He still would not provide information, so LTC [REDACTED]

DETAILS

██████████ pulled him by his neck to the clearing barrel and pushed his head inside the clearing barrel so his head was touching the sand. While LTC ██████████ held his head two other soldiers held his arms. LTC ██████████ proceeded to remove his weapon from his holster and placed it about one foot away from Mr ██████████ head, then fired one shot into the barrel very close to Mr ██████████ head. When LTC ██████████ fired the weapon, Mr ██████████ became hysterical and thought he was going to be killed by LTC ██████████. The Egyptian interpreter continued to question him, but he would not provide any information. After a few more minutes of interrogation, LTC ██████████ finally took him back to his cell in the detainment facility. About two hours later, a medic came to his room to examine him. The medic attempted to give him something intravenously (IV), but he refused it because he did not know what it was. The medic then provided him two bottles of water and some pills. Mr ██████████ stated he did not provide any information to LTC ██████████ because he did not have any to provide. Mr ██████████ stated LTC ██████████ never struck him nor stated he would kill ██████████ if he did not talk.

Agent's Comment: At the beginning of the interview Mr ██████████ stated he was never in the detainment facility at Taji and that he was working with the United States Government to assist their efforts in Iraq. When Mr ██████████ realized he was being interviewed as a victim, his story changed and he stated he was detained and abused by the above personnel.

<p>In reference to the allegations of assault and conveyance of a threat against an Iraqi National, Mr. [REDACTED] the following is my statement for submittal. I am guilty of conveying a threat against said individual by the drawing and firing of my assigned 9mm pistol in his proximity. I did not at any time strike the individual but did observe my Soldiers do such, never to his face, and restrained them if they were taking their actions to far. I would like to now give a background on this incident.</p> <p>On or about Friday, 8 August and informant came to the Gunner gate of FOB Gunner, Taji Iraq. This informant gave information relating to an assassination plot against myself, LTC [REDACTED] and one of my subordinate battery commanders, CPT [REDACTED]. This information was briefed at the nightly Gunner plans meeting by the Gunner S2, CPT [REDACTED]. I was then instructed by COL [REDACTED] to confine my activities to the FOB until this issue was further developed. One week later on Saturday, 16 August there was an IED and small arms fire attack against a convoy that had just departed Saba al Boor. The convoy contained CPTs [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] who had just completed CMO activities on my behalf. This route is normally taken either to enter or depart from Saba al Boor. Also, Saturdays are the normal days for my weekly district council meetings, either afternoon or mornings.</p> <p>The informant came back later the following week and supplied the names of three personnel that had been conducting meetings reference the assassination plot. One of the names was [REDACTED] a police officer in Saba al Boor. Based upon that intelligence and knowing his work schedule we launched a snatch team to the police station led by CPT [REDACTED] and my CSM to apprehend the individual. We had police registration pictures so we knew his identity. Mr. [REDACTED] was apprehended with a minor struggle at which he went for his 9mm sidearm and was subdued. At that time Mr. [REDACTED] stated that he would tell us anything we needed to know.</p> <p>It was Thursday, 21 August when this snatch occurred and the following day we were to conduct local selections. It was well known as to where the stations were by published flyer. Therefore it was deemed critical to ascertain if, where, and when a potential attack would occur.</p> <p>Mr. [REDACTED] was transported to the Gunner collection point and through interrogation by CI team he was not divulging any information. I was concerned for the impending safety of my Soldiers and myself and did go to the collection point. I cannot remember the time but it was after dark. I asked for volunteer Soldiers and had several who accompanied me, SSG [REDACTED], SPC [REDACTED], SPC [REDACTED], and PFC [REDACTED]. Upon arrival at collection point I spoke with SPC [REDACTED] and Ms. [REDACTED] DA interpreter. They both admitted frustration with Mr. [REDACTED]. He was being evasive and belligerent to them. We had him separated into a cell and began re-interrogating him reference names of his accomplices, location and time of a potential attack. After approximately 25 minutes nothing was giving. Yes, there had been sporadic body punches and shoving to the individual, which I witnessed but did not allow to get too brutal. I had drawn out my pistol as a means of conveying a threat to him for the seriousness of wanting the information.</p> <p>I then directed that Mr. [REDACTED] be taken out of the collection point and had the translator tell him I had had enough and that this is where it will end. I asked him again to tell us what he knew and when he again shunned the question I did lean him forward toward the clearing barrel and fire a shot. In my anger I do not know if I fired two shots into the barrel or one into the air and another into the barrel that is of no consequence. I fired my weapon. Afterwards, Ms. [REDACTED] come in upon my direction and Mr. [REDACTED] came forth with names, location, and method of the attack. It was to occur Friday morning in Saba al Boor vicinity of the police station by positioned snipers supposedly being brought in from Fallujah. Mr. [REDACTED] was to ID my vehicle and myself for these rooftop firers. We took this information and the following day established flask CPs and used AH-64s overhead. There was no attack and no further attacks have emanated from the town since the apprehension of Mr. [REDACTED] and his named associates.</p> <p>I accept full responsibility for my actions and accept any punishment. I acted in the best interest for my Soldiers and yes myself. The night of this action I informed COL [REDACTED] what I had personally done firing my weapon. I also had Mr. [REDACTED] examined by my PA, 1LT [REDACTED] who reported back no serious injuries or bleeding on Mr. [REDACTED]. The following day at my Battalion update brief I informed by Battery Commanders, ISGs, and staff of my actions. This was not to boast but rather personally accepting responsibility and to not attempt to conceal my actions. I did embellish some points for emphasis.</p>

A: My issued 9MM pistol.

Q: Did you have a round chambered in the pistol?

A: I don't think I chambered a round until I went outside.

Q: Was it your intentions to have a round chambered in your weapon while you were inside the detainment facility?

A: Sitting on my right leg, top of my thigh, with the barrel of the weapon pointed towards the detainee.

A: I don't recall the exact words I used, but I think I told him if he doesn't talk I would kill him.

Q: Why did you upholster your weapon?

A: Just to scare the detainee because we were not getting any information by talking.

The unit that brought the detainee stated he had resisted and force was used to detain him and that he was involved in a plot to kill LTC [REDACTED]. The detainee was complaining about his ribs area so I called the medic to check him out. After examination was determined that he had bruised ribs. Later the interrogator SPC [REDACTED] and interpreter [REDACTED] came to question him. Myself and a soldier escorted him to the interrogation room where I, as had been directed in my instructions to the Summer Collection Point, stayed with my soldier as guard during the interrogation. The detainee didn't give up any information. SPC [REDACTED] called LTC [REDACTED] on the radio and told him she didn't get any information. LTC [REDACTED] called her and said tell him he has one hour to tell us the information I want or I, LTC [REDACTED], am gonna come kill him. I along with my soldier, SPC [REDACTED] escorted the detainee back to the interrogation room. With instructions from the interrogator, I stood next to the detainee and stomped my foot on the ground, to create an intimidating environment, after questioning the detainee, little or no more information was recovered. SPC [REDACTED] contacted LTC [REDACTED] again and said that no info was attained. LTC [REDACTED] said tell him I'm enroute. When LTC [REDACTED] showed up along with 4 soldiers, they came into the interrogation room. LTC [REDACTED] sat down in front of the detainee and said "I came here for one of two reasons, 1 to get the information I need or 2 to kill you". LTC [REDACTED] had changed his pistol at this time. It was questionable though when LTC [REDACTED] put the weapon to his head, this is when I was concerned.

Once at Gunner Jail LTC [REDACTED] exited the vehicle and walked toward a holding cell and we followed suite. As soon as I heard that my heart started pounding faster because if they kill him chances are they're going to kill me too being LTC [REDACTED] gunner. As the interrogator asked questions that the translator interpreted to the detainee and I guess the translator didn't like the fact that he tickled her so she kicked him several times. She kicked him several more times after that. Then I lost it threw my M4A1 down and grabbed the detainee and said who the fuck is trying to kill him, that's when SSC [REDACTED] hit him followed by all of us present except LTC [REDACTED] and the interrogator who just told us to hit him. When we got to the jail they already had the detainees in another room and [REDACTED] 7C5 665 the JA translator was with him. LTC [REDACTED] 7C5 665 took his individual equipment off but kept his pistol. Then he sat in front of the detainee with the pistol on his lap and told him "I'm here for a reason, you are going to tell me who wants to kill me or I'm going to kill you". After that the JA translator would ask the detainee some questions and then slapped or kicked him. After a while the detainee started smiling and telling LTC [REDACTED] 7C5 665 "I love you". At that point one of my soldiers threw his kevlar on the ground and cursed the detainee and pushed him, then I came from the side and punched the detainee on the side of the head. At that point LTC [REDACTED] 7C5 665 told me to back up and someone else told me not to punch him on the head or face. After that I helped the detainee to sit down again. This asking and beating continued for about 40 min. and at that time I turned away. I left the room after I started hearing hitting and grunts (bells). He told me to try one more time to see what we could get. So we proceeded outside gunner collection point. When we got outside Ltc [REDACTED] 75665 shot his gun out in the direction of the open area across from the collection point. I don't remember exactly, but I do know I talked to [REDACTED] 75665 some more and now I'm frustrated so I get up and walk away ^{towards [REDACTED] 75665} and his guys grab [REDACTED] 75665 and were not going to let anyone the same as I told him before - [REDACTED] 75665 I tell Ltc [REDACTED] 75665 and he goes over to the guy. I see them put his head in the clearing barrel. I turn away. The next thing I know I see Ltc [REDACTED] 75665 wear a gun shot. I turn around in shock and see Ltc [REDACTED] 75665 clearing his weapon. After that we pretty much closed things up and ended it.

A: No, I did not. I purposely turned away and walked out because I did not want to see it or hear it. 1) because I knew it was wrong on many levels and 2) because I don't like (to witness or see) violence.

Q: When you returned to the room, after the detainee was hit, did you notice if the detainee had injuries or in pain?

A: No I did not notice any injuries. He had been holding his side when he first came in the room for us to start interrogating him, but we were told the medics had cleared him for questioning. So occasionally I did see him hold his side, but I did not notice him pay attention to any new areas of pain.

Q: From what you saw, who was hitting the detainee?

A: I saw LTC [REDACTED] 705605 soldiers move towards the detainee from this. I assume it was them doing the hitting.

Q: Did MS [REDACTED] 705605 the interpreter or any other soldier not mentioned, hit the detainee?

A: I'm not sure. I did not see her or any other soldier hit the detainee, but that is because I turned away and left.

Q: Did you strike the detainee or instruct other soldiers to strike the detainee?

A: No, I did not. I don't condone violence. I know sometimes the implication is required for a fear up approach and I do my job but I have never and never will strike or instruct someone else to strike another individual (detainee).

Q: Did LTC [REDACTED] 705605 or any other soldier tell the detainee he would be killed if he did not answer questions and provide information?

A: Yes, LTC [REDACTED] 705605 did tell this to the detainee - he would be killed if he did not give us the information about the attack.

A: EPWs I was always told not to abuse them, use verbally abuse them, due to Geneva Convention, but I was not briefed on civilian detainees.

Q: Do you feel that Ms [redacted] and LTC [redacted] influenced your actions on the evening in questions?

A: No, everybody is in charge of their own actions, if I was in LTC [redacted] position, I probably would have done the same thing.
