

This office was notified by the Provost Marshal's Office, 4ID, Camp Ironhorse, Tikrit, Iraq, APO AE 09323, of a self inflicted gunshot wound to the foot of PFC *b7C-5, b6-5* following his theft of money while on a raid of suspected Fedayeen homes.

Investigation established probable cause to believe PFC [redacted] committed the offense of robbery, when as a member of a patrol team he stole 180,000 Iraqi Dinar from two homes he was searching.

Further, investigation established probable cause to believe PFC [redacted] committed the offense of Malingering, when he shot himself in the foot after being informed he would be recommended for disciplinary action for stealing the money.

I also witness PFC [REDACTED] earlier in the day par-take in weapons maintenance and clearing class. I personally observed the above mentioned soldier break down his weapon for I was sitting directly across from him. All this occurred during our Safety Day Classes with me present throughout the training.

The Incident in question happened approximately 1 hour after the completion of classes. There was no operational reason why PFC [REDACTED] had a round chambered and his weapon on fire, PFC [REDACTED] was well aware of the weapon status for the day "Green Direct" - At no time did I elevate the weapon status. when I questioned PFC [REDACTED] he was unwilling to tell me what had happened. I gave a class on how to properly clear a weapon. I immediately following the class I had all the soldiers clean their weapons. I physically saw PFC [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-4 weapon in two pieces about one and a half hours prior to the incident. I seen him actually cleaning his lower receiver.

At the time of the incident I ran to the site where the [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-4 incident had occurred. I found PFC [REDACTED] b7c-5, b6-5 laying on his belly in obvious pain. We then rolled him over to find he had shot himself in the foot. He had an indentation in his boot and a black ring around the whole where the projectile entered.

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

Because my platoon was detached from the rest of our company, we were unable to inform the Company Commander until later that evening when my Platoon Sergeant made a face to face with our company First Sergeant back in the company assembly area. We then searched PFC [REDACTED] 67C-4, 66-4 and Sgt [REDACTED] 67C-4, 66-4 and found nothing. Lt [REDACTED] 67C-4, 66-4 who was searching PFC [REDACTED] 67C-4, 66-4 then approached me with a small wad of money. There was two wads. One was neatly folded and contained 13, 10,000 Dinar bills. I, [redacted] WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH:

About 1100, on 29 May 03, my platoon was clearing a small village near Tuze, Iraq. We stopped to eat chow after several hours of patrolling and searching homes. While we were taking a break, an Iraqi man (NFI) approached and stated he was from the village where we had just left and that his mother's home was just searched. The Iraqi male stated someone within the platoon had stolen thirteen (13) 10,000 dinar bills, totaling 130,000 dinars from the home. A second Iraqi male approached and also stated he had 70,000 dinars stolen. Both Iraqi males identified PFC [redacted] and SGT [redacted] as the individuals who had searched their homes. SFC [redacted] the platoon sergeant, searched SGT [redacted] and did not find any dinars. I searched PFC [redacted] and found two small wads of money. One wad of money was neatly folded and contained thirteen (13) 10,000 dinar bills and the other contained five (5) 10,000 dinar bills. SFC [redacted] and I questioned PFC [redacted] who did not have an explanation for how or where he got the money. We returned the money to the Iraqi males and pitched in the difference to what was stolen.

Q: SA [redacted] A: LT [redacted]

Q: On the day that the money was determined to be taken from the homes, where the other members of the team searched?

A: Yes, PVT [redacted] and SPC [redacted] were also searched and nothing was found.

Q: Has there been any other past situations regarding items missing from homes that were searched?

A: No.

Q: Where you a witness to the shooting involving PFC [redacted]?

A: No, but SFC [redacted] did but is now back at Fort Carson, CO.

Q: Did anyone on the team witness PFC [redacted] steal the money?

A: No.

Q: Did PFC [redacted] say anything prior to the shooting to indicate he was going to cause a self inflicted wound because he was facing UCMJ action for stealing the money?

A: No, he didn't say anything to me. I did tell him that I was going to recommend him for UCMJ action to the company commander.

Q: What was PFC [redacted] explanation for having the money?

A: He said it was change from a \$20.00 bill that was used to for a phone call and several sodas that he had made the previous two days.

Q: Do you have anything else to add to this statement?

A: I found the money in PFC [redacted] vest. The money was in the exact bundle and denomination that the Iraqi's said and also, it had rained the previous 2 days and the wads were crisp bills. I held the wad of money

I, *b7c-5, b6-5*, WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH:

On 29 May 03, my platoon was conducting a patrol of a village outside of Tuze, Iraq. We searched about six or seven houses for contraband. When we search the houses, we are always in teams of two, my partner for that day was PV2 *b7c-3, b6-3*. During the searches we found a one AK-47 rifle with a few magazines, and a bundle of 250,000 Dinar bills. We stopped for lunch after a few hours of searches, we approached by an Iraqi male who said he had lost some money, and pointed to SGT *b7c-4, b6-4* and PV2 *b7c-3, b6-3*. The Iraqi male then said that SGT *b7c-4, b6-4* and PV2 *b7c-3, b6-3* were searching his house. SFC *b7c-4, b6-4*, my platoon sergeant, asked if anyone took the money, which everybody said no. SFC *b7c-4, b6-4* then began to search the platoon. The Iraqi male said he had lost a total of 180,000 Dinar, which is equal to about \$52.00 U.S. Dollars. A few soldiers had 10,000 to 20,000 Dinar, and they found 160,000 Dinar on me. I had gotten the Dinar by exchanging it from the U.S. money my wife sent me. SFC *b7c-4, b6-4* took my money away from me, and then said everyone else has to come up with 20,000 Dinar to make up for the 180,000 Dinar that the Iraqi male said was stolen. Nobody came up with the 20,000 Dinar, and we then moved back to the company area. While at the company area, I approached SFC *b7c-4, b6-4* and asked him why he took my money away. He told me "why do you think I took it, the Iraqi male said he reported 180,000 Dinar were stolen, and you had 160,000 Dinar within your possession." I then told him that I always carry money, and the money I find during searches I always give to PV2 *b7c-3, b6-3* for accountability, who then puts it back were I found it. I also told him to ask PV2 *b7c-3, b6-3* if he took the money, at which point PVT *b7c-3, b6-3* denied taking the money. PV2 *b7c-3, b6-3* then approached me and wanted to fight so that SFC *b7c-3, b6-3, b7c-4, b6-4* would forget about the missing Dinar. I then asked him why he wanted to fight me since we are friends. PV2 *b7c-3, b6-3* replied if we fight, SFC *b7c-4, b6-4* would forget about what happened today, and we would not have to come up with the 20,000 Dinar. I told PV2 *b7c-3, b6-3, b7c-4, b6-4* to get with SGT *b7c-4, b6-4* and have him give the \$25.00 U.S. Dollars that he was going to give me to SFC *b7c-4, b6-4* in order to make up for the 20,000 Dinar. The \$25.00 from SGT *b7c-4, b6-4* was part of the \$100.00 U.S. Dollars he had found from conducting searches the night before. I wanted to pitch in the \$25.00 to make up for the 20,000 Dinar so PVT *b7c-3, b6-3* would leave me alone and quit trying to fight me. The next day, 30 May 03, I was using the latrine in the burn pit, when I heard somebody coming behind me, I put my kevlar on my head, and picked up my rifle, which was laying to my right, with both hands and I jumped up, and I heard a shot. I then realized it was SFC *b7c-4, b6-4* behind me and he asked if I hurt myself, and I told him I don't feel anything, but as he approached closer, he told me I had just shot myself in the foot, and to stay there while he went and got help. SFC *b7c-4, b6-4* left and two or three medic came back to tend to my injury. I was shot in the left foot. I was then *b7c-5, b6-5*

I, *b7C-4, b6-4* want to make the following statement under oath:
 On or about 29 May 2003 at approximately 11:00 hours myself and my platoon had completed a search of a village in eastern Iraq. We were taking a break for lunch about two kilometers from the village we had just searched when we were approached by a local villager who claimed that someone matching Pfc. *b7C-4, b6-4* had stolen 180,000 Dinar from his a home in the village. He described the denominations as 13 10,000 Dinar bills that were new and neatly folded with a rubber band around them and 50,000 Dinar were stolen from a different house. The woman the money had been stolen from came to the scene and pointed out Pfc. *b7C-4, b6-4* and Sgt. *b7C-4, b6-4* as the two individuals that searched her home. Through a translator the lady said she wanted no trouble, she just wanted her money back. She was missing 130,000 Dinar and another gentleman was missing 50,000 Dinar. I assembled my platoon after conferring with my Platoon Leader (Lt. *b7C-4, b6-4*) and we told the Iraqi nationals to come back in 30 minutes. I address the platoon in general and told them of the allegations and told them if anyone had stolen the money to just please.. return it and this would be over. After several pleas no one came forward. The Iraqis returned and I asked them to please point out again who was in their home. They again pointed out Pfc. *b7C-4, b6-4* and Sgt. *b7C-4, b6-4* so I asked to search them and they both consented. I found nothing in Sgt. *b7C-4, b6-4* bags or on his person however, Lt. *b7C-4, b6-4* found 13 10,000 Dinar bills folded in half with a rubber band on them in Pfc. *b7C-4, b6-4* flak vest. Pfc. *b7C-4, b6-4* later came to me and blamed the theft on two other soldiers. The next day on 30 May 2003 at approximately 13:30 hours I left our perimeter to use the latrine and while doing so I spotted a large lizard and I attempted to take a picture of it, however, it kept scampering away so I followed it and I finally got a picture on the crest of a small hill. After doing so I looked up to find a good place to relieve myself and that is when I spotted Pfc. *b7C-4, b6-4* sitting on the crest of a creek bed. That is when I heard the shot go off and seen Pfc. *b7C-4, b6-4* fall back. I ran to him and began to evaluate him for injuries. I asked what he was doing and initially he said the weapon went off as he was climbing up the creek bed, however, once I told him I was there and I know he was not climbing up the creek bed he began to cry and repeatedly say "oh no ,oh no". I found an entrance wound on his left foot with gun powder on his boot

1. This office is currently conducting an investigation regarding a Robbery and Malingering.

2. On 10 Jun 03, this office was notified by the provost marshal office, 4th Infantry Division, *b7c, b6-5*
 (4ID) camp Ironhorse, Tikrit, Iraq, of a self inflicted gunshot wound to the foot of PFC *b7c-5, b6-5*
 [REDACTED] C Co, 1/8th Infantry Battalion, 4ID, APO AE 09323 (Tuze, Iraq), following his theft of money while on a raid of suspected fedayeen homes.

b7c-5, b6-5 Preliminary investigation disclosed PFC *b7c-5, b6-5* [REDACTED] was a member of a patrol team whose duties were to search and seize contraband while patrolling a small village located outside of Tuze, Iraq. After several hours of patrolling the village the unit came to a halt to have lunch. While the unit was halted an unidentified Iraqi male approached the unit and alleged PFC [REDACTED] stole *b7c-5, b6-5* 110,000 dinar (approximately \$110.00 us dollars) from his mother's house and 70,000 dinar (approximately \$70.00 us dollars) from another unidentified house. A subsequent search of PFC *b7c-5, b6-5* [REDACTED] equipment and personal belongings led to the discovery of 180,000 dinar in his possession. The mother and unidentified male found the dinars as described in two separate bundles in the denominations identified by each.

Further investigation disclosed PFC *b7c-5, b6-5* [REDACTED] shot himself in the foot the following day after being informed he would be recommended for disciplinary action for his actions on the previous day.

3. On 17 Sep 03, 2LT *b7c-5, b6-5* [REDACTED] C Co, 1/8th Infantry *b7c-5, b6-5*

Request your office locate, fully identify, and conduct witness interviews of SGT *b7c-4, b6-4* [REDACTED] PVT *b7c-3, b6-3* [REDACTED] and PVT [REDACTED] and obtain a sworn statement regarding the events leading to the discovery of dinars on PVT [REDACTED] *b7c-3, b6-3*. Further, request your office coordinate with the unit commander to determine course of action being sought for PFC [REDACTED] *b7c-5, b6-5* and determine if PFC [REDACTED] *b7c-5, b6-5* is back in Iraq. 1. On 10 Jun 03, this office initiated an investigation regarding the offenses of Robbery and Malingering pertaining to a self inflicted gunshot wound to the foot by PFC [REDACTED], [REDACTED] C Company, 1/8th Infantry Battalion, 4ID, Tuze, Iraq. b7C-5, b6-5
2. Preliminary investigation disclosed that on 29 May 03, PFC [REDACTED] was a member of a patrol team whose duties were to search and seize contraband while patrolling a small village located outside of Tuze, Iraq. After several hours of patrolling the village, the unit came to a halt in order to have lunch. While the unit was halted, an unidentified Iraqi male approached and alleged PFC [REDACTED] stole 110,000 Dinar (approximately \$110.00 US dollars) from his mother's house and 70,000 (approximately \$70.00 US dollars) from another unidentified house. A subsequent search of PFC [REDACTED] belongings led to the discovery of 180,000 Dinar in his possession. The Dinar was found as described, in two separate bundles in the denominations identified. Further, investigation disclosed on 30 May 03, PFC [REDACTED] shot himself in the foot the following day after being informed he would be recommended for disciplinary action for his actions on the previous day.
3. Request your office locate, fully identify and conduct a subject interview of PFC [REDACTED]. Obtain a sworn statement regarding his actions on 29 - 30 May 03. Further, obtain major case prints and mug shots. Conduct any other investigative activity, deemed necessary. Request acknowledgement upon receipt of RFA.
