Investigation disclosed that on 20 Aug 03, at Camp
Vigilant, Compound A, BCCF, detainee TALEB, while detained
by U.S. Forces died as result of Arteriosclerotic
Cardiovascular Disease and the manner of death was natural.

This investigation established probable cause to believe Mr. TALEB died of natural causes due to a myocardial infarction.

Basis for Investigation: This office was by the 320th Military Police (MP) Battalion, Abu Ghurayb Prison, Baghdad, IZ of an Iraqi Prisoner, Mr. Emad Kazam TALEB, Internment Serial Number #150186, NFI, died of Myocardial Infarction while detained in the prison.

About 1130, 21 Aug 03, SA [REDACTED] and SA [REDACTED] both this office, coordinated with SSG [REDACTED] 54th Quartermaster, Baghdad International Airport, IZ who provided copies of the Certificate of Death pertaining to Mr. TALEB, which listed his cause of death as Myocardial Infarction. (See Certificate of Death for details) *b7C/b2/b6*

About 1140, 21 Aug 03, SA [REDACTED] utilized a Digital Sony Cyber-Shot, 3.2 Mega Pixel with built in flash and exposed photographs of the victim. There were no identifying tattoos to the victim, but a small 4-inch scar to the left wrist area. (See Photograph packet for details) *b7C/b2/b6*

About 1631, 4 Sep 03, SA [REDACTED] coordinated with 1LT [REDACTED] B CO, 109th Area Support Medical Battalion (ASMB), Vermillion, South Dakota 57069, who was a member of the medical personnel assigned to Abu Ghurayb Prison. 1LT [REDACTED] stated, about 2240, 20 Aug 03, he responded to Mr. TALEB situation. Mr. TALEB was unresponsive, had no pulse, and was not breathing. Mr. TALEB was given an IV and an application of a Defib/Monitor. Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) was conducted for about 25 minutes after which 1LT [REDACTED] pronounced Mr. TALEB dead at 2300, 20 Aug 03. 1LT [REDACTED] added that preliminary cause of death was myocardial infarction and manner of death was natural. *b7C/b2/b6*

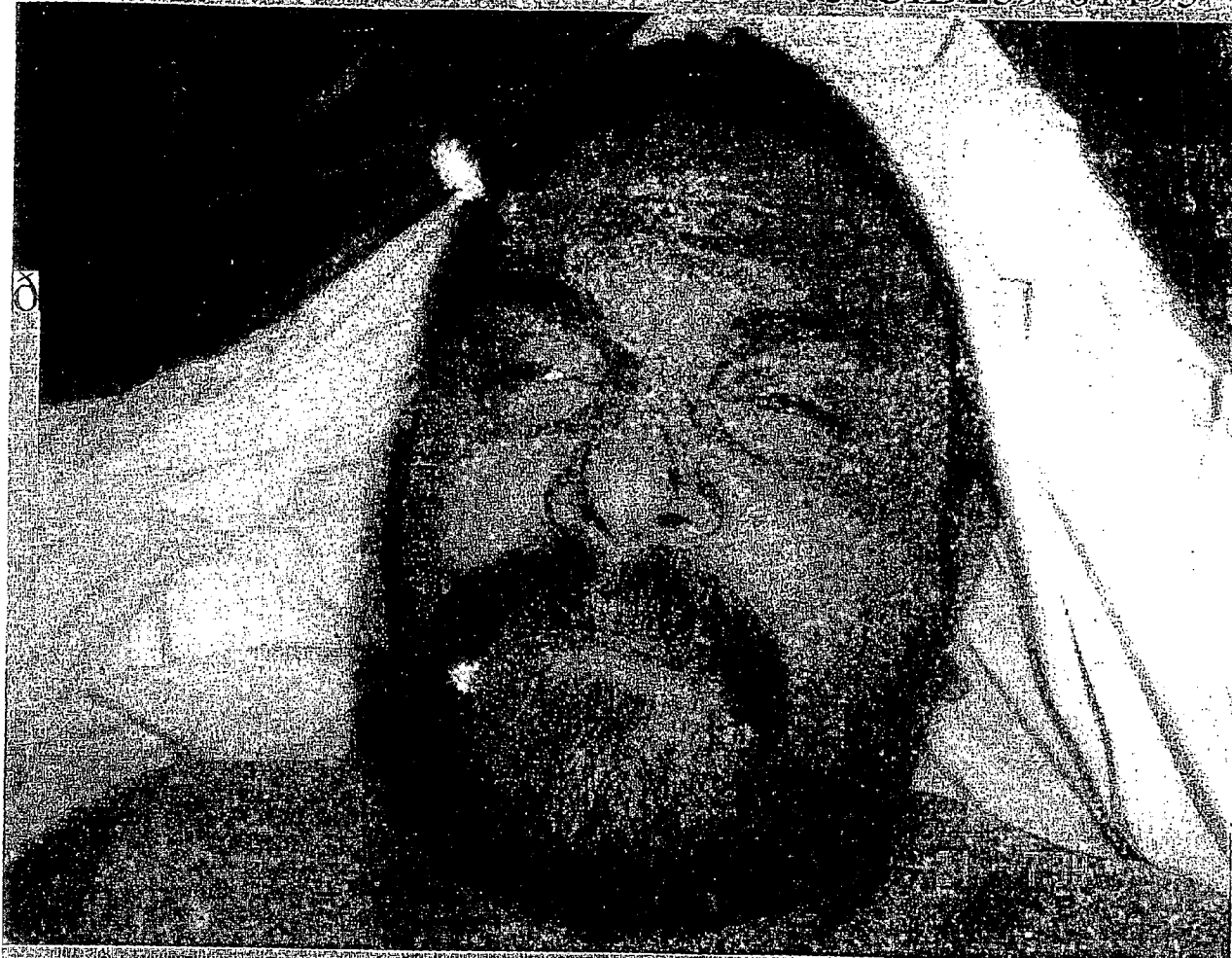

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PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATION REVEALED MR. EMAD KAZEM TALEB, A U.S. ARMY IRAQI DETAINEE, DIED WHILE BEING DETAINED AT ABU GHURAYB PRISON, BAGHDAD, IRAQ.

INVESTIGATION DISCLOSED MR. TALEB WAS TAKEN TO THE PRISON MEDICS GASPING FOR AIR, BUT WAS BREATHING AND HAD A PULSE. U.S. ARMY MEDICAL PERSONNEL ATTEMPTED LIFE SAVING PROCEDURES TO REVIVE MR.
