- 2. The review disclosed the following deficiencies. The investigation did not conduct a crime scene examination or explain why such an examination was not conducted. The investigation did not conduct any interviews of people with the victim at the time of the incident. A local national medical person mentioned in a narrative summary provided by an U. S. Army medical NCO as having pertinent information was not interviewed. Though U.S. Army medical personnel alleged the victim had a preexisting medical condition aggravated by a self imposed hunger strike, the investigation did not obtain any medical records or conduct interviews to substantiate the information. The case file contained two CD ROM disks and a 3-1/2 floppy disk; however, none of the three disks contained any documents or photographs. The floppy disk was read as unformatted, and the two CD-ROM's contained only a MS Windows operating system "shortcut" to a PDF file. The case file did not contain any copies of the photographs. The original case file did not contain copies of the preliminary or final autopsy reports, or the 1st supplemental report or final supplemental report. The case was opened as an undetermined death, and closed as final (c) accidental death, with the cause of death listed as cardiac arrest.
