This is an Operation Iraqi Freedom Investigation.

This office received a Serious Incident Report from the 320th MP BN regarding the death
of a prisoner at the BCCF.

Investigation determined Mr. AL-HUSSEN died as a result of Myocarditis. An autopsy
by CPT (Dr) [REDACTED] USN, Regional Armed Forces Medical Examiner, b7c-3, b6-3
Portsmouth Naval Hospital, Portsmouth, VA 23708, determined Mr. AL HUSSEN died as
a result of Myocarditis and the manner of death was natural.

INVESTIGATION SUMMARY:

This is an Operation Iraqi Freedom Investigation.

This office received a Serious Incident Report from the 320th MP Bn regarding the death of a prisoner at the Abu Ghraib Prison, Baghdad, IZ.

Investigation determined Mr. AL-HUSSEN died of unknown causes after collapsing during morning prayers. An autopsy by CPT (Dr) [REDACTED] b7c-3, b6-3 USN, Regional Armed Forces Medical Examiner, Portsmouth Naval Hospital, Portsmouth, VA 23708, determined the preliminary cause and manner of death were undetermined, but found no evidence of significant trauma.

Basis For Investigation: This office was notified by an Incident Report, 320th Military Police Battalion, Baghdad Correctional Facility, Abu Ghraib, IZ of the death of a detainee. Mr. BAKER. (See Incident Report for details)

About 1415, 16 Jan 04, SA ^{b7c-1, b6-1} interviewed SPC ^{b7c-4, b6-4} [REDACTED] Combat Medic, 870th Military Police (MP) Company, 320th MP Battalion (BN), Baghdad Correctional Facility (BCF) APO AE 09335. SPC [REDACTED] stated the prisoner was brought ^{b7c-4, b6-4} to the medical clinic about 0900, 16 Jan 04, from the Iraqi Medical Clinic, BCF where he was pronounced dead after falling during morning prayer in his cell. SPC [REDACTED] was not ^{b7c-4, b6-4} present nor did he work on reviving the victim. He did state there was no external trauma to the body, knife wounds or any signs, which would indicate a struggle. SPC [REDACTED] there was ^{b7c-4, b6-4} Cyanosis of the lips (bluing). No intravenous fluids were provided to the detainee.

About 1415, 16 Jan 04, SA ^{b7c-1, b6-1} interviewed LTC (DR) ^{b7c-4, b6-4} [REDACTED] 220th MP Battalion, BCF, who provided a sworn statement detailing his knowledge of the death. LTC [REDACTED] stated there was no signs of struggle or foul play to the body and ^{b7c-4, b6-4} Cause of death was cardiac arrest. (See sworn statement for details)

About 1445, 16 Jan 04, SA ^{b7c-1, b6-1} [REDACTED] conducted a viewing of the victim. Observations consisted of Livormortis present in the shoulder blades and back. Search for any physical external trauma revealed negative results. The victim was estimated between 25 to 35 years of age, brown complexion, with trimmed and maintained beard and eyes were closed. The victim was wearing only what appeared to be Pajama style bottom pants and was wrapped in a multi colored blanket.

About 1600, 16 Jan 04, SA ^{b7c-1, b6-1} [REDACTED] coordinated with CPT ^{b7c-3, b6-3} [REDACTED] S-1, HHC, 320th MP Bn., BCF, APO AE 09335 who provided the following information pertaining to this investigation:

Dr. ^{b7c-4, b6-4} [REDACTED] Physician, BCF, Abu Ghraib, IZ pronounced Mr. BAKER dead at 05:45, 16 Jan 04. Cause of death was listed as Cardiac Arrest. (See death certificate for details)

On 16 Jan 04, Dr. ^{b7c-4, b6-4} [REDACTED] provided a statement detailing the death of Mr. BAKER. BAKER was found in his cell suffering from fully dilated pupils and absence of heart beat and respiration. (See statement of [REDACTED] for details) ^{b7c-4, b6-4}

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On 16 Jan 04, Mr. ^{b7c-7, b6-7} Wing Supervisor, ^{b7c-7, b6-7} BCF, Abu Grahaib provided a statement an Arabic statement detailing his knowledge of the incident.

On 16 Jan 04, Mr. ^{b7c-7, b6-7} Arabic statement was translated into English. Mr. ^{b7c-7, b6-7} stated while on duty the victim, was notified by Mr. ^{b7c-4, b6-4} Detainee ^{b7c-4, b6-4} shares the cell with the victim. Mr. ^{b7c-4, b6-4} stated during their morning prayer the victim fell over dead. ((See Arabic statement of ^{b7c-7, b6-7} and English translation ^{b7c-4, b6-4} for details)

On 16 Jan 04, Mr. ^{b7c-4, b6-4} provided an Arabic Statement detailing his knowledge of the ^{b7c-4, b6-4} incident. Mr. ^{b7c-4, b6-4} stated during morning prayer Mr. BAKER fell over dead. (See Arabic ^{b7c-4, b6-4} statement and English translation for details)

On the above date and time this writer (SSG [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-4) was notified that a detainee #9550 (Baker Yassen Rashed Mahmed Al Hussien) from 2A-123 was carried out to the hallway by ICOs and was possibly not breathing. On initial observation it appeared that detainee was not breathing and was immediately sent to the BCDF Clinic. Prisoner was immediately sent to the BCDF Clinic in which Iraqi Doctor working on shift [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-4 began to evaluate and perform a few chest compressions. At 0546hrs Dr [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-4 declared that the detainee had expired and claimed it could have been a heart attack or something with his brain. Initial investigation from eyewitness detainee [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-4 revealed that at approximately 0530hrs himself [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-4 and detainee #9550 was praying in their cell 2A-123 and that detainee #9550 suddenly collapsed on the floor. Detainee [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-4 stated that at no time did detainee #9550 complain of any pain during the morning or during prayer. Detainee [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-4 immediately notified ICO Wing Supervisor [REDACTED] b7c-7, b6-7 and Wing ICO [REDACTED] b7c-7, b6-7 who immediately wrapped detainee #9550 in a blanket and was carried to the BCDF Clinic. Detainee #9550 was left at clinic for removal and possible further investigation.

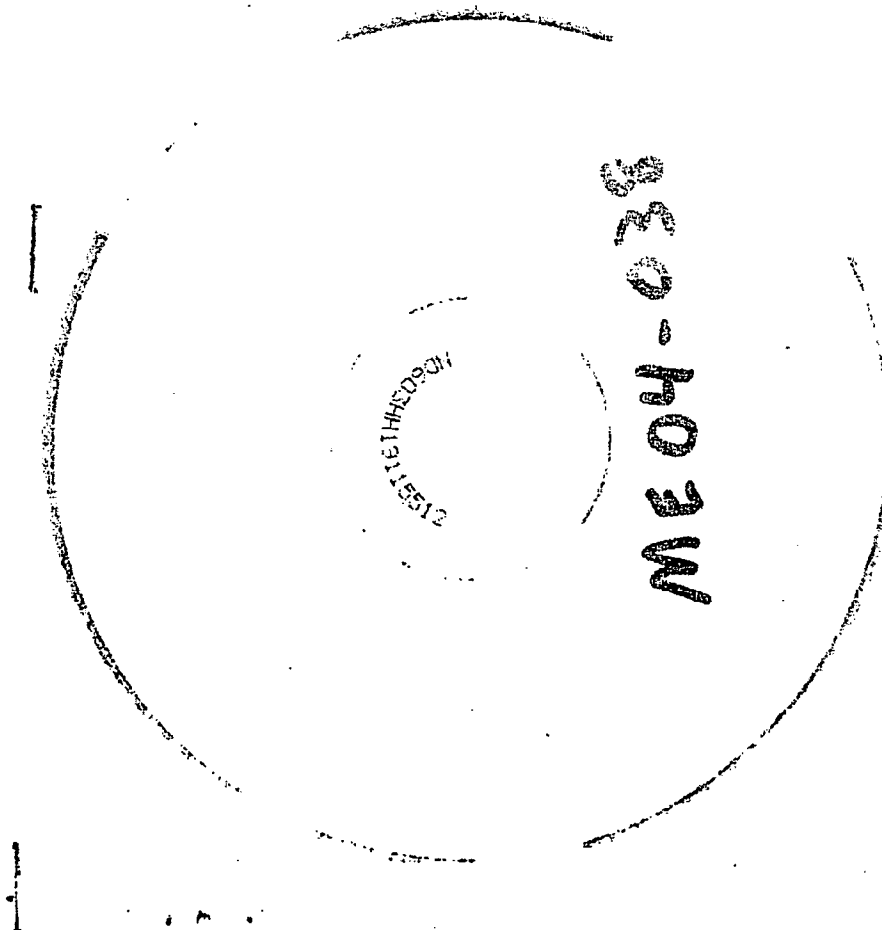


