An autopsy by MAJ (Dr.) Deputy Medical Examiner, Office of the Armed Forces Medical Examiner (OAFME), determined the preliminary cause of death to be acute peritonitis secondary to a perforating gastric ulcer, and the preliminary manner of death as natural.

On 20 Aug 04, this office received a Request for Correction (0454-04-CID001), from Headquarters, United States Army Criminal Investigation Command (HQUSACIDC) to reflect the Leads Remaining in the Status paragraph and add the Final Autopsy Report.

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On 20 Aug 04, this office received the Final Autopsy Report #ME 04-101, 25 Jun 04, which revealed the cause of death as Acute Peritonitis secondary to Perforating Gastric Ulcer and the manner of death as Natural.

Interviewed SPC 320th Military Police Co. Aby Ghriab Prison, Baghdad, Iraq, APO AE 09335. Both SPC and SPC were medics assigned to treat prisoners at the prison. SPC stated that he initially saw Mr. ABDULLAH during sick call at compound 6. Mr. ABDULLLAH was conscious and breathing and had walked to sick call. Through another prisoner, Mr. ABDULLAH told him that he could not urinate and felt dizzy. SPC ABDULLAH to lay down and that he would consult the doctor and return after sick cail. About 30 to 40 minutes later, before he could consult a doctor, SPC was recalled to compound 6. Several other prisoners carried Mr. ABDULLAH out of his tent wrapped in blanket. Mr. ABDULLAH was breathing but he appeared to be unconscious. SPC and a third soldier transported Mr. ABDULLAH to the prisoner in-processing center. Once there, they worked on Mr. ABDULLAH for several minutes before Dr. (LTC) pronounced Mr. ABDULLAH dead.

SPC stated that he was not with SPC during SPC initial visit with Mr. ABDULLAH at compound 6. SPC said he helped SPC and the third soldier transported Mr. ABDULLAH to the in-processing center and treated him there.

Both SPC and SPC believed the third soldier who helped them transport Mr. ABDULLAH to the in-processing center was SPC of the 119th MP Co, Abu Ghriab Prison, Baghdad, Iraq, APO AE 09335. SPC was not available to be interviewed.


