#### **INVESTIGATIVE SUMMMARY:**

On 24 May 04, this office received the Final Autopsy Report of Mr. ZAID from the Armed Forces Institute of Pathology (AFIP), Rockville, MD, which disclosed Mr. ZAID died while in U.S. custody on 22 Aug 03.

Investigation disclosed while Mr. ZAID was being detainee at the 1/13<sup>th</sup> Armor Bn Detention Facility, Baghdad, Iraq, when he was found lying on the ground with shallow respirations and decreased sweating. Emergency medical services were summoned and Mr. ZAID was found to have an axillary temperature of 102 degrees and decreased oxygen saturation. Mr. ZAID was then transported to Kadamiya University Hospital where he was pronounced dead upon arrival. The autopsy report reflected Mr. ZAID's cause of death as Heat Related and the manner of death was Accidental.

A review of the files of the previous deployed detachment disclosed Significant Data File 0101-03-CID899 was initiated to document the death of Mr. Mr. ZAID.

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DETAILS

RASIS FOR INVESTIGATION: About 1800, 24 May 04, this office was notified of the death of Mr. ZAID through the receipt of his final autopsy report.

About 1800, 24 May 04, SA reviewed Mr. ZAID's final autopsy report, which stated he was a detainee at the 1/13<sup>th</sup> Armor Bn Detention Facility, Baghdad, Iraq, when he was found lying on the ground with shallow respirations and decreased sweating. Emergency medical services were summoned and Mr. ZAID was found to have an axillary temperature of 102 degrees and decreased oxygen saturation. Mr. ZAID was then transported to Kadamiya University Hospital where he was pronounced dead upon arrival. The autopsy report reflected Mr. ZAID's Cause of Death as Heat Related and listed his Manner of Death as Accidental.

AGENT'S COMMENT: A review of the closed cases of this office revealed that on 24 Aug 03, a USACIDC investigation was conducted under Significant Data File 0101-03-CID899 to document the death of Mr. BYATY.
