PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATION REVEALED THE ICRC REPORT RELATED MR. UNDERWENT ILL-TREATMENT IN AN AMERICAN MILITARY BASE IN FALLOUJAH IN MID-APRIL 04. THE ICRC REPORT RELATED MR. WAS SUSPENDED FROM HIS THIGHS AND WAS BEATEN WHILE HE WAS HOODED AND RESTRAINED. THE ICRC REPORT RELATED HE HAD CIRCULAR MARKS ON BOTH WRISTS AND EXCORIATIONS ON THE RIGHT INTERNAL MALEOLUS AND LEFT EXTERNAL MALEOLUS.
