EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

[U] THREATS/AGGRAVATED ASSAULT - TAJI, IRAO [USACIDC]: Self-initiated. On 19 Sep 03, CID was notified that an Iraqi detainee was threatened and assaulted at the Gunner Collection 2-20th FA Bn, 4ID, while conducting aninterrogation of the detainee, unholstered his assigned 9mm pistol and told the detainee that he would be shot if he did not provide information regarding an alleged plot to kill LTC others. LTC clearing barrel, and fired two shots from his pistol into the barrel while the pistol was next to the and detainee's head. During the course of the interrogation and in the presence of LTC soldiers [2-SPC/1-PVT] and a local Iraqi interpreter, reportedly punched and kicked the detainee in the chest and legs multiple times. On 20 Sep 03, LTC admitting to his involvement. Investigation continues by Army CID.
