**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

1. A request for assistance was received from U.S. Army Criminal Investigation Command (CID) Afghanistan to locate and conduct a victim interview [REDACTED] is currently detained aboard Naval Station Guantanamo Bay, Cuba. Efforts to interview [REDACTED] met with negative results.

**NARRATIVE**

1. Investigation was initiated into a suspected violation of Article 128 (Assault) of the UCMJ.

2. A request for assistance was received from U.S. Army CID Afghanistan to locate and conduct a victim interview [REDACTED] is currently detained aboard Naval Station Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, exhibit (1) pertains.

3. On 12JUL04 contact was made with [REDACTED] Prosecutor, Office of Military Commissions (OMC), (703) 602-4173, to determine the legal status of [REDACTED] as it would relate to his being interviewed.

4. [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] was represented by counsel and it was her recommendation [REDACTED] not be interviewed because charges were being preferred in the near future.

5. On 13JUL04 charges were preferred against [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] related [REDACTED] should not be interviewed until after the entire Military Commission process has been completed. CID was notified of the decision of OMC. The interview of [REDACTED] will not be conducted until the completion of the Military Commission process. CID should liaison directly with OMC on this issue. This specific phase investigation is closed.
