He said that he is only allowed to use the bathroom every six hours, which hinders his water intake. There are times during the day when he feels very dizzy. He said if he could be moved back to general population, he could increase his water intake and minimize his dizzy spells.

Furthermore, he stated that it was also his opinion that if Saddam Hussein had WMD, he would have definitely used it against the U S [redacted]
