SA processed prisoners at two separate locations, on two occasions he processed detainees inside the ABU Ghurayb prison in a side storage room off to the side of the prison cell block. He didn't recall if that area actually had a particular name. The second location where he processed the majority of the detainees was outside in a tent on the ABU Ghurayb prison grounds SA stated the processing of the detainees occurred around October 2003, generally between the hours of 10am to 5pm, two to three times per week.
