[redacted] was interviewed at Camp Delta, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, by United States Air Force Office of Special Investigations (AFOSI) Special Agent [redacted] Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) SA [redacted] and United States Department of Defense (DOD) Contract Language Specialist [redacted]. [redacted] translated the interview in [redacted]. [redacted] furnished the following information:

[redacted] advised that he had just been released from the fleet hospital approximately 30 minutes before the interview started. He advised that he has [redacted] in the past [redacted]

[redacted] denies anything secret in his travels and stated that he had no linkage to any other interests and swore that he would sign his own execution order if he had lied to the interrogators.
