[redacted] advised he does remember them asking him [redacted] advised that statement was untrue and only provided in an attempt to end the interrogation. [redacted] was asked by the American interrogators for the name of [redacted] advised he provided the interrogators with a name, however, he is unable to remember the name he provided at this time.
