On 12/02/2002, [REDACTED] b6 -2,3,4  
[REDACTED] was interviewed at the United States Naval Base, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba. Also present for b7C -2,3,4  
the interview was Special Agent (SA) [REDACTED] Naval Criminal Investigative Service. The b7D -1  
interview was conducted in Arabic, and Department of Defense contract language specialist [REDACTED] b7F -1  
[REDACTED] provided [REDACTED] translation. After being advised of the identity of the interviewing  
agent and the nature of the interview, [REDACTED] provided the following information:

[REDACTED] had heard that 40-50 detainees intended to commit suicide after Ramadan ended because b6 -3,4  
they were tired of being detained with no prospect of being released and they were tired of being b7C -3,4  
mistreated by the guards. [REDACTED] did not know how they intended to commit suicide but had heard b7D -1  
that the act would only take about 10 minutes. [REDACTED] had no intention of committing suicide b7F -1




