That he saw the doctor and medicine was prescribed to him but has not arrived. Agents provided a cough drop and told [redacted] that agents would submit a request, to the guards, for him to see the doctor.

[redacted] told agents he has heard of a mass suicide plan in the camp. [redacted] some three hundred detainees are going to commit suicide in a one hour period.

[redacted] told agents he believed there were several reasons for this mass suicide. [redacted] told agents the detainees have lost all hope and have been mistreated by the guards.

[redacted] told agents, it was his understanding, that the detainees who are going to commit the mass suicide are waiting for the FATWA, or permission, from the religious leader of the camp to commit the act. Normally suicide would be a sin.
