[redacted] was interviewed at Camp Delta, United States Naval Base, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba by Special Agent [redacted] Federal Bureau of Investigation. The interview was conducted in English. After being advised of the purpose of the interview [redacted] thereafter provided the following information:

[redacted] is currently in isolation and is unsure how long he will remain there. [redacted] believes that he did not do anything that warranted his being sent to that cell block. [redacted] realizes he cannot win a confrontation with the military guards and would not initiate a physical confrontation with one of them. [redacted] believes the guards have continued to treat him harshly since the incident he had with them [redacted]

[redacted] initially indicated that he would answer no more questions regarding his case saying that he has answered everything already and it is in the file. [redacted] continues to feel that detainees, including himself, are being held unjustly. Detainees left their home countries because of injustices and now the same injustices are happening to them here. [redacted] means the interviewer no disrespect but feels that after a year the investigation should be complete.

[redacted] indicated that he had already answered that question. The interviewer told him that another detainee had reported [redacted]
