Since he says he is not AL QAEDA, no one will believe him. [redacted] stated he is innocent. He went on to say that he has lied to interrogators in the past. When asked what he lied about, he stated he could not recall all the lies. He stated that as we talk, he will try to remember his lies. [redacted] was asked why he lied. He stated that he lied while in Bagram. He indicated he was in a lot of pain and both his legs were severely injured. He was not treated well by the guards and he was afraid if he told the truth, he would be treated worse. He wanted to receive medical treatment and he was afraid if he told the truth, the Americans would amputate his leg(s). He went on to say that when he was captured he was not armed; therefore, he cannot understand why he is in Cuba. He stated if he wanted to be in a war, he would have stayed in [redacted].
