Additionally [REDACTED] claimed that he was upset by having to wear a hood while in transit and that guards did not respond to a pain in his ear. Further, [REDACTED] alleged that the guards beat him. While in transit [REDACTED] informed the translator of his ills and was told that a doctor would see him later.
