(U) Details: ~~(S)~~ "Memoranda for Record" interrogation reports and plans are documents generated by the Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA), Defense Human Intelligence Service (DHS). DIA-DHS is running Special Projects teams of interrogators at Guantanamo Naval Base, Cuba. Tactics of concern are being directed by U.S. Navy Reserve Lt. [redacted] EUCOM Liaison Officer to the Joint Task Force at Guantanamo, who is employed in civilian life as a Detective with the Chicago PD.

b6 -4 detainee [redacted] who was arrested at the request of the U.S. at [redacted] and detained in Jordan for several months. b7C -4 before being turned over to the U.S. [redacted] was held in Bagram and then transferred to Guantanamo where he has been assigned detainee number [redacted] and FBI case number 315N-MM- C99102-AA671...

b6 -1,4 [redacted] was interviewed over an extended period through May 2003 by FBI San Diego SA [redacted] and FBI San Francisco SA [redacted]. During these interviews [redacted] admitted close associations and a family relationship with another terror suspect, but he denied personal involvement in terror activities. The FBI set leads to obtain evidence b7C -1,4 information to corroborate or discredit [redacted]'s information and held off confrontational interviews until such time as lead results were returned. SAs [redacted] and [redacted] departed Guantanamo in late May 2003.
