Details: Supervisory Special Agent [redacted] Behavioral Analysis Unit 3 (BAU3), National Center for the Analysis of Violent Crime (NCAVC), Critical Incident Response Group (CIRG), was deployed to GTMO to assist with the interviews being conducted by FBI agents during the period of June 12, 2003 - July 3, 2003. During this time, SSA [redacted] consulted with numerous interview teams consisting of FBI agents and U.S. Air Force Office of Special Investigations agents for the purpose of developing interview strategies to be used in the interviews of GTMO detainees. SSA [redacted] observed interviews of the detainees on an almost daily basis during that period.
