Synopsis: To provide information as to official travel to Guantanamo Bay (GTMO) and observance of treatment of detainees.

Details: Electronics Technician (ET) [Redacted] Telecommunications Intercept and Collection Technology Unit (TICTU), traveled to GTMO on January 18, 2002 through January 22, 2002 and once again on July 22, 2002 through July 26, 2002 for a site survey and installation of technical equipment. ET [Redacted] worked in the vicinity of the detainee camp and had the opportunity to view most of the camp at any given time. During the entire deployment at GTMO, ET [Redacted] did not observe any aggressive treatment of detainees.
