SA [REDACTED] never observed any aggressive treatment of detainees during his TDY in GTMO. No detainees ever showed signs of injuries other than what occurred during the course of combat during the Afghanistan war in 2001. No detainees complained of physical force being used against them. These statements about a lack of aggressive treatment hold true for all FBI personnel observed in GTMO by SA [REDACTED] as well as the other investigating agencies from the Department of Defense, to include the Defense Intelligence Agency.
