Synopsis: Negative observation of inappropriate interview techniques employed at Guantanamo Bay, Cuba.

Administrative: E-mail message from Steven C. McCraw, dated 07/09/2004, sent at 2:42 p.m.

Details: SA [redacted] Detroit Division, performed temporary duties at Guantanamo Bay, Cuba in support of Operation Enduring Freedom from 07/12/2002 through 08/13/2002. During this time period, SA [redacted] did not observe any actions directed towards detainees that violated the FBI's interview guidance/policy. It was SA [redacted] personal observation that detainees were treated as respectfully and humanely as possible under the conditions present by all personnel who came in contact with them.
