Synopsis: To document a negative response to the canvass for Bureau employees who observed aggressive treatment, interrogations or interview techniques on GTMO detainees which was not consistent with Bureau interview policy/guidelines.

Administrative: Re Bureau e-mail, dated 07/12/2004 Assistant Director (AD) Steven C. McCraw, Inspection Division.

Details: In a Bureau e-mail, dated 07/12/2004, the Inspection Division requested information from employees who observed any aggressive treatment, interrogations or interview techniques on GTMO detainees which was not consistent with the Bureau's interview policy and guidelines. SA [REDACTED] Houston Division, served a Temporary Duty (TDY) Assignment at GTMO to interview and interrogate detainees from July 10, 2002 through August 14, 2002. During the TDY assignment, SA [REDACTED] did not witness any aggressive treatment, interrogations or interview techniques being employed on GTMO detainees. On the contrary, SA [REDACTED] witnessed very humane treatment and observed most agents utilizing the reward technique during interviews and interrogations, whereas detainees were rewarded with food or other items for their cooperation. SA [REDACTED] served the TDY assignment along with Task Force Officer (TFO) [REDACTED] Houston Division.
