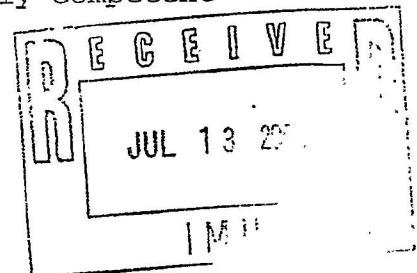

During the course of the deployment, author observed no mistreatment or aggressive treatment of detainees. Additionally, author observed no abuse of detainees during interviews or interrogations. Author wishes to note that, during his deployment, all interaction between military/other U.S. government personnel and the GTMO detainees were conducted in an extremely professional and highly competent manner.
