	Synopsis: (U) Provide negative response to inquiry.

	Details: (U) On 7/09/2004, SA (author), received an e-mail from Steven C. McCraw, Inspection Division, requesting that author provide him with information related to author's deployment to U.S. Naval Base, Guantanamo Bay (GTMO), Cuba. Specifically, Mr. McCraw requested author inform him as to whether he witnessed any "aggressive treatment, interrogations or interview techniques on GTMO detainees which was not consistent with Bureau interview policy/guidelines".
(U)	Author was deployed to GTMO from 1/27/2004 to 1/29/2004 in conjunction with the AMERITHRAX investigation. During the course of the deployment, author observed no mistreatment or aggressive treatment of detainees. Additionally, author observed no abuse of detainees during interviews or interrogations. Author wishes to note that, during his deployment, all interaction between military/other U.S. government personnel and the GTMO detainees were conducted in an extremely professional and highly competent
