Synopsis: Advise receiving office of NO observed mis-treatment of detainees during TDY deployment.

Details: From 05/16/2002 thru 06/20/2002, writer was deployed to Guantanamo Bay, Cuba for the purpose of interviewing detainees captured in Afghanistan by the United States military.

To the writer's knowledge, interviews of which the writer partook were conducted in accordance with to FBI policy and guidelines.

Interview teams, called "tiger teams," were made of a mixed group of interviewers from various agencies, task forces and military criminal and/or intelligence groups. The writer's group consisted of an FBI agent, an investigator with a military intelligence group and an investigator from the U.S. Army Criminal Investigation Division (CID).

Writer observed no detainee mistreatment during his entire TDY.
