Synopsis: Response to Office of Inspections tasking to the field regarding interviews.

Details: SA [Redacted] served a TDY in Bagram, Afghanistan in April-May, 2003. During that time, SA [Redacted] conducted numerous visits to the Bagram Collection Point (BCP) for coordination and interviews of detainees, including full access to the facilities, to include areas where detainees were been held separate from the general population. At no time did SA [Redacted] observe any detainee being treated roughly, inhumanly, or in any way being humiliated or abused. SA [Redacted] interacted with the MP detachment at the BCP, and at times with CID and Military Intelligence. There were no instances of inappropriate actions by any individuals at the BCP directly observed or brought to the attention of SA [Redacted]
