Details: Contractor personnel assigned to the Electronic Surveillance Operations Support Office (EOSO) within the Electronic Surveillance Technology Section of the Investigative Technology Division have intermittently supported the CTD with regard to installation, administration, maintenance, and user training of systems used at GTMO in support of Operation Enduring Freedom. The personnel assigned to support these functions worked in a facility physically isolated from the detainee areas and had no personal contact with detainees or conversations with any military guard, investigator, or interrogator about detainee activities.

The email sent by Steven C. McGraw identified only a subset of EOSO personnel who supported CTD efforts in GTMO. The following comprehensive list includes all EOSO personnel assigned to GTMO for the periods identified. None of the identified personnel observed any aggressive treatment of detainees.
