Synopsis: Reference is made to AD McCraw E-mail dated 7/9/2004, and SAC Wiser E-mail dated 7/15/2004. This communication documents a negative reply regarding observation by SAC Wiser of aggressive treatment of detainees at GTMO.

Details: Referenced AD McCraw E-mail requires a response regarding detainee treatment at GTMO observed by then-Inspector Wiser. Referenced SAC Wiser's E-mail documented a negative reply regarding observation of aggressive treatment.

During or about October 14, 2003, then-Inspector Leslie G. Wiser, Jr., arrived at Naval Base, Guantanamo Bay, for the purpose of determining FBI investigative jurisdiction regarding alleged espionage activities by linguists and other personnel assigned to Camp Delta. Departure was on or about the morning of 10/16/2003. Then-Inspector Wiser was accompanied by SSA [redacted] SSA [redacted] and a DOD official from the Counterintelligence Field Activity (CIFA).

On or about 10/15/2003, a briefing and tour were conducted at Camp Delta. Prisoners were observed in transport and in quarters/cells. No aggressive treatment was observed and the briefing did not indicate aggressive treatment. The total time at Camp Delta was approximately two hours, possibly less.
