SUBJECT: INDIA SEEKS CONSULAR ACCESS FOR CITIZEN IN IRAQ

Secretary (US and Canada) Sujata Mehta requested US assistance in obtaining consular access to an Indian citizen reportedly in the custody of the Coalition Provision Authority (CPA). According to Mehta, the GOI was informed of detention (perhaps on weapons charges) by the ICRC in January. The CPA is holding in the Abu Ghraib prison. She stated that the prison facility identified by reference numbers 116289 and/or 15967. She indicated that the Indian Embassy in Baghdad would make a parallel approach to CPA and the Iraqi authorities.
