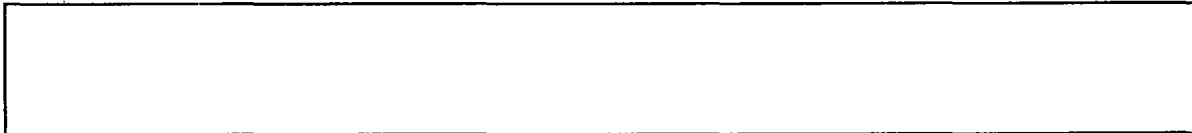

SUBJECT: [] Guantanamo Detainee B6, B7(A), B7(C)

[] Ambassador [] came to see me today to ask for further information on the status of the [] detainee at Guantanamo. I alerted him to the fact that a [] would soon come to Washington for expert-level B6, B7(A), B7(C) meetings on the [] detainees. I suggested that, if needed, his government could send a team to Washington for discussions about the [] case. Ambassador [] welcomed the idea, agreeing that public knowledge of such discussions could help [] address domestic concerns about this case. He indicated that [] would likely raise the subject with you when you meet July 22.
