(C) AFTER POINTING OUT HEIGHTENED INTEREST ON THE PART OF THE MEDIA AND HUMAN RIGHTS GROUPS CONCERNING THE TREATMENT OF THE DETAINEES, PLEUGER SUMMARIZED A PRESS STATEMENT FOREIGN MINISTER FISCHER HAD MADE THAT AFTERNOON. MINISTER FISCHER HAD STATED THAT THE DETAINEES SHOULD BE TREATED AS PRISONERS OF WAR (POWS) AND IN CONFORMITY WITH THE GENEVA CONVENTION, WITH CONSIDERATION FOR HUMANE TREATMENT, PROTECTION OF HUMAN DIGNITY, PROTECTION FROM VIOLENCE, ACCESS TO MEDICAL TREATMENT, AND DUE PROCESS IN COURT.
