- ISRAEL/PALESTINIANS: ROADMAP, ARAFAT, AND CONTROL OF PALESTINIAN SECURITY SERVICES
- U.S. POSITION TOWARDS ARAFAT & EXILE O: WHAT IS THE U.S. VIEW OF ARAFAT AND RENEWED ISRAELI SUGGESTIONS THAT EXILE IS AN OPTION?
- AS WE'VE SAID MANY TIMES BEFORE, NOTHING HAS CHANGED WITH RESPECT TO OUR POLICY TOWARDS ARAFAT. THE SECRETARY HAS MADE CLEAR THAT ARAFAT IS PART OF THE PROBLEM - NOT PART OF THE SOLUTION. - -- FOR OUR PART, WE WILL CONTINUE TO WORK WITH ALL THOSE WHO ARE COMMITTED TO PURSUING THE VISION PRESIDENT BUSH LAID OUT IN HIS JUNE 2002 SPEECH, INCLUDING REGIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL LEADERS. THE SECRETARY CALLED ISRAELI FOREIGN MINISTER SHALOM OVER THE WEEKEND, AMBASSADOR KURTZER AND ACTING CONSUL GENERAL JEFF FELTMAN CONTINUE ACTIVE DISCUSSIONS WITH BOTH SIDES. AMBASSADOR WOLF IS IN THE REGION MEETING WITH OFFICIALS FROM BOTH SIDES, ENCOURAGING THEM TO REMAIN ENGAGED.

KEY POINTS ON ISRAELI STRIKES IN GAZA & MOVES INTO OALQILIYA:

- -- 1483 AND 1500 WERE KEY RESOLUTIONS THAT LAID OUT POSTWAR PLANS FOR <<IRAQ>> AND UNDERSCORED THE UN,S ROLE. THIS PROPOSED RESOLUTION BUILDS UPON THESE EARLIER ONES AND IS AN ADDITIONAL EFFORT TO REAFFIRM THE UN,S ROLE AND ENCOURAGE THE FULL AND ACTIVE INVOLVEMENT OF THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY.
- -- IT ALSO REFLECTS THE FACT THAT WE HAVE LISTENED TO OTHERS AND THAT WE BELIEVE IT, S TIME FOR THE SECURITY COUNCIL TO STEP UP AND DO ITS UTMOST TO RESTORE CONDITIONS OF STABILITY AND SECURITY TO <<IRAQ>>, FOR THE WELL BEING OF THE IRAOI PEOPLE.

QUESTION: CAN YOU DRUM UP SUFFICIENT SUPPORT IN THE SECURITY COUNCIL?

ALL AGREE THAT A STABLE AND SECURE << IRAQ>> IS IN EVERYONE, SINTEREST. PARTICULARLY AFTER THE RECENT BOMBINGS, AS THE SECRETARY SAID (8/29), &THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY MUST RENEW ITS COMMITMENT TO WORKING WITH THE MAJORITY OF THE IRAQI PEOPLE WHO SEEK TO BUILD A FREE AND STABLE COUNTRY.8 POWELL
