I WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH:

I swear that the summary statement given to me on 25 May 2004, is accurate and complete. It is not verbatim, but does contain the substance of all statements made by me.

I have two sisters and five brothers. One brother named [redacted] died at [redacted] I live in [redacted] lives about a half an hour away.

One day my brother [redacted] was sick and a friend of his was taking him to the hospital. On the way to the hospital they were both stopped by [redacted] and captured. This was during Ramadan. I went to the police station and I didn't find him. Someone at the station took me to a small police station in another area. I saw a man driving a car and my brother was next to him. They told me "here is your brother, it was a mistake that they picked him up," so they released him. I took him to the hospital because he was badly hurt. He said that [redacted] some other Iraqis hurt him.

Two days later some Americans came to my house with [redacted] searching my house and looking for my brother. It was two o'clock in the morning. [redacted] asked me where my car is. I told him it was in a garage. He walked with me to the garage and he told me "If you don't pay me money, we won't let your brother alone". There was an American soldier walking with me when we went to the garage.

My neighbors, who had been harassed by [redacted] before, told me not to give him any money because he won't leave you alone. So, I didn't give him any money. Then on the 20th day of Ramadan my house was raided, and they broke down my door, took my money - a couple hundred dollars, and took me to an old IAS station building, once used by [redacted]. The [redacted] who came were shooting outside my house, and they said they were going to investigate this shooting.

They took me to an IAS station, down to the basement. [redacted] said, "do you think we are going to leave you alone? You promised to pay me money." At the IAS station there were three Iraqi policemen who sat around me. There was a linguist with [redacted] who was either Saudi or Kuwaiti. The three Iraqi IP beat me from one o'clock until six o'clock. They said that I was a rich woman and I said no, it is my sister. My husband is a prosecutor. The Iraqis were young and didn't seem very intelligent. There was an American guard and when the Iraqis left me alone he took care of me. In the morning they put me in an open truck and people were saying, "leave this woman alone." They took me to Adamiya Palace and asked me questions while they made me stand up. I was then released and I went home. When I was held I was hit on the wrist with a water pipe.

On December 23 I was in my car with two children when I was stopped by a car with an American, a linguist, who looked Kuwaiti or Saudi and [redacted]. I tried to run away. The American took my car, and I went with [redacted] and the dark skinned man. They took me back to the IAS station and put me in a room where an American soldier, claiming to be the commander, insisted that I tell him about my sister, uncle, and brothers or threatened to put me back in the basement. I was then left by myself with [redacted]. He told me that he would never let me see the sunlight again. I was there with the children until ten o'clock. We got a call that said take the kids to the police station.

I then went with the American, and the linguist to drop off the kids at the police station. I was then taken to [redacted] where I saw [redacted] and the American commander. They cuffed me from behind and pushed me where there were a lot of people. I saw my sister. I said, "why are you here." She said she brought our brothers for investigation and they kept her. I was kept at Adamiya Palace for four or five days where I was beaten and made to stand the entire time I was there.

They pushed my brother [redacted] body in front of me. He was beaten badly. I saw my sister, and my brother [redacted] who was

I was almost gone. I found out that [REDACTED] had arrested my brother [REDACTED] three days prior to my arrest, at a bar, along with everyone at the bar. Everyone from the bar but my brother was released and they told me that he was beaten very badly.

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I was at [REDACTED] for four or five days. While I was at [REDACTED], I was interrogated by an American who wanted me to admit that my sister [REDACTED] headed my brothers who supported terrorists. An American soldier tried to scare me by putting electric wires all around me, and he beat me up. I did not see him because I was blindfolded, but I felt him while he was talking to me. I was sitting in a cot, but they took me into another area. I sat on the ground. There were people screaming, a lot of people. I hit my head to see what was happening. I saw the linguist who was with [REDACTED] and he was shaving the bottle on five or six people. I saw them stick a bottle up several people's rectums, one after another. I did not see [REDACTED]. Then they put tape on my eyes and I couldn't see.

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I didn't see [REDACTED]. The day I saw them put the bottles in the people [REDACTED] was there with the American soldier, and the linguist. There were six of us that were transported from Adamiya to the police academy. All six of us were beaten up between the palace and the police academy so bad we were bleeding. I had blood on me from the other people being beaten. There were a lot of Americans present. I was at the police academy for six days. I didn't see my brothers or sister at the police academy until two days after I arrived. At the police academy they told me my brother [REDACTED] died.

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My sister was beat at Adamiya by stepping. Her shoulder was also hurt when they were lifting her up.

After I left the police academy, they brought me to Abu Ghraib. My brothers and sister weren't doing anything against the Coalition forces, and we have done nothing wrong. Adamiya Palace is on the river. I heard the American unit called "Charlie" unit, and I don't know the unit name. I don't know the names of any the American soldiers. The American soldier that stepped me was medium height, good shape, and in his forties. And he was with [REDACTED] all the time. One of the linguists was named [REDACTED] and the other linguist was tall with dark skin. [REDACTED] was kind of chubby, medium height, black eyes, and always in civilian clothes. I heard he used to work for the Bush party.
