Basis For Investigation: This investigation was initiated upon notification from HQ, U.S. Army Criminal Investigation Command, Inspector General's Office reported SFC [REDACTED] Headquarters and Headquarters Company, (HHC), 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion, 325th Infantry Regiment, Fort Bragg, NC 28310 (FBNC) reported he witnessed a detainee being struck by a soldier while deployed to Iraq. *b7c, b6*

Details:

*b7c b65*  
A review of the Inspector General's Complaint revealed while on a search for weapons mission of a warehouse. PVT [REDACTED] platoon encountered approximately 5 security guards with weapons that were performing security on the warehouse. The platoon entered the building and secured the warehouse facility. Upon completion of detention, the security guards were escorted outside to a more secure environment according to Standard Operating Procedure (SOP). While outside the guards were ordered to take a knee or sit down and be quiet. One security guard began to get loud and aggressive in Arabic and came to his feet. While coming to his feet in an aggressive manner, with his hands behind his head, the detainee spit on PVT [REDACTED]. It was reported that PVT [REDACTED] reacted with a right back hand strike to the top of the guards head. *b7c b65*

About 1330, 3 Jun 04, SA [REDACTED] conducted a witness interview of SFC [REDACTED] who related he witnessed PVT [REDACTED] strike a detainee upon the head with a right back hand. He related he did not think PVT [REDACTED] intended to abuse the detainee but reacted to the aggression of the detainee. (See Sworn Statement for details) *b7c b64*

WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH:

IN MARCH OF 2003 MY UNIT 2<sup>ND</sup> BN 325<sup>TH</sup> AIR DEPLOYED FROM FORT BRAGG, NC TO ARAB SAUDI ARABIA TO STAGE FOR THE INVASION OF IRAQ. IN APRIL WE CONTINUED TO TRAIN AND CLIMATE FOR OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM. ON 01 APRIL WE CONDUCTED AN AIR MOVEMENT TO TELIAL AIRBASE, AND A CONVOY TO ASSAMANA, IRAQ. THERE WE CONDUCTED AN ATTACK IN SECTOR TO SECURE THE MSR TO ALLOW FOR VEHICLE MOVEMENT THROUGH THE CITY. MY PLATOON SECURED SEVERAL BLOCKS IN THE CITY, CLEARING ROOM TO ROOM THROUGH OUR ENTIRE SECTOR OVER SEVERAL DAYS. AFTER ABOUT 2 WEEKS OF PATROLING, ROUTE SECURITY AND WEAPONS RAIDS, WE MOVED TO AL-DIWANIYA WHERE WE PICKED UP SECURITY OPERATIONS CONDUCTED PATROLS AND ESTABLISHED NUMEROUS OVERWATCH AND SECURITY POSITION AND TRAFFIC CONTROL POINTS. WE THEN MOVED TO AR RAMADI TO RELIEVE 3<sup>RD</sup> ID FORCES IN SECTOR. CONDUCTING SIMILAR OPERATIONS WITH EN FORCES AND CROWD CONTROL AND POLICE SUPPORT. IN ABOUT MID MAY WE ARRIVED IN BAGHDAD. ONCE IN BAGHDAD WE WERE ASSIGNED TO MAINTAIN SECURITY IN THE AL-DOURA AREA WITH THE COMPANY RECEIVING THE NATIONAL STEEL COMPANY AND AL-DOURA REFINERY AS OUR PRIMARY SECURITY FOCUS. INITIALLY MY UNIT WAS ATTACHED TO 75<sup>TH</sup> REGIMENT IN ARAB SAUDI ARABIA, THEN AT TELIAL WE REMAINED OUR BRIGADE AND DIVISION AND WHEN WE ENTERED BAGHDAD WE CAME UNDER 1<sup>ST</sup> ARMOR DIVISION. AS AN ATTACHMENT OF 1<sup>ST</sup> ARMOR WE WERE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE A PLATOON MINUS TO SUPPORT 1/1 CAV AT CAMP STRIKER NEAR BAGHDAD INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT TO PROVIDE DISMOUNTS FOR DAILY PATROLS AND OPERATIONS.

DURING ONE OF THESE OPERATIONS, A SEARCH OF A WAREHOUSE COMPLEX TO LOCATE WEAPONS IN SOUTH BAGHDAD OPERATING AS AN INDEPENDENT ELEMENT BUT ATTACHED TO 3/1 CAV. WE ENTERED A COURTYARD WITH ABOUT EIGHT WAREHOUSES FOUR ON EITHER SIDE A REAR WALL AND A GATED FRONT WALL. FOR THIS OPERATION OUR PLANNED ENTRY METHOD WAS A 'KNOCK AND ENTER' WITH SHOTGUN BREACH AS A BACKUP. WE ARRIVED

IN THREE VEHICLE, DISMOUNTED AND ORGANIZED, WHILE I WAS PLACING VEHICLES AND ENSURING SECURITY, THE PLATOON LEADER CONDUCTED THE INITIAL ENTRY OF THE COMPOUND AND SECURITY OFFICE. THEY SECURED FOR FOUR OR FIVE PERSONNEL AND THREE AK-47 ASSAULT RIFLES. ONE OF THE PERSONNEL SPOKE PASSABLE ENGLISH BY THE TIME I ENTERED THE COMPOUND THE IRAQIS WERE ALREADY SECURE AND THE PL WAS EXPLAINING WHAT WE WERE DOING TO THE ENGLISH SPEAKER. THE IRAQIS WERE MOVED TO A CENTRAL LOCATION AND PLACED UNDER A TWO MAN SECURITY TEAM CONSISTING OF PFC [REDACTED] A DISTANT OVERWATCH MAN AND PVT [REDACTED] A NEAR SECURITY MAN, THE IRAQIS WERE NOT TIED BUT THEY WERE PLACED IN A KNEELING POSITION WITH THEIR HANDS BEHIND THEIR NECKS AND TOLD IN ENGLISH AND IN ARABIC TO STAY DOWN AND TO BE QUIET. SEVERAL TIMES THEY HAD TO HAVE THESE ORDERS REPEATED. I MOVED TO ONE SIDE AND TOOK A KNEE SO AS TO BE ABLE TO SEE MORE OF THE OPERATION THAT WAS ONGOING. AT ONE POINT I HEARD LOUD ARABIC COMING FROM THE DETAINEE CONTROL POINT I COOKED TO SEE ONE OF THE GUARDS QUICKLY GET TO HIS FEET IN FRONT OF THE NEAR SECURITY MAN, PVT [REDACTED], PVT [REDACTED] STRUCK THIS MAN WITH THE BACK OF HIS HAND THEN RETURNED HIM TO HIS KNEES. THE PLATOON LEADER 2LT [REDACTED] CALLED ME INSTRUCTIONS TO REPLACE PVT [REDACTED]. I THEN MOVED PFC [REDACTED] IN TO NEAR SECURITY AND PVT [REDACTED] TO OVERWATCH. AS I WAS DOING THIS I EXPLAINED TO [REDACTED] AND [REDACTED] THAT YOU CANNOT STRIKE POWS AND WHY. SHORTLY AFTER WE WERE COMPLETE WITH THE MISSION, WE RETURNED ALL THE WEAPONS AND RELEASED THE DETAINEES, LOADED THE VEHICLES AND RETURNED TO THE COMPANY STAGING AREA. DURING THE PLATOON AAR LT [REDACTED] REINFORCED THAT WE DO NOT STRIKE DETAINEES (SAFE GUARD) AND THE

I was the platoon leader for 3rd platoon B 2-325 from APR 03 until MAY 04. In JUN-JUL 03 3rd platoon was attached to 1/1 CAV 1 AD. One mission was to conduct a raid on a compound based on intel that the facility was being used to store and traffic insurgent's weapons. After entering the compound we found 4-5 Iraqi males and at least one AK-47 rifle. The Iraqis were placed under watch of a security detail while the rest of the platoon continued the raid. From a position about 50 meters away I could still hear the Iraqi men and security detail yelling at each other. I yelled over to the guards that no one over there should be talking. A short while after I gave that order I saw PFC [REDACTED] strike one Iraqi who appeared to be trying to stand up. I don't know where any other soldiers were standing when this happened. The Iraqi men were further separated and there were no further incidents. We finished the raid. As we were leaving the Iraqis told my translator that the other Iraqi man was trying to stand because his knees hurt. We did not detain any of the Iraqi men or keep the weapon. Back at the command post I talked to PFC [REDACTED] and his NCO support channel. PFC [REDACTED] told me he saw the man refusing his orders and rising toward him as a threat. I concluded PFC [REDACTED] was reacting to perceived threat and acted in accordance with the ROE. He used the minimum force needed. Given that the number of Iraqis was greater than the number of guards I felt PFC [REDACTED] used great restraint in not knocking out the Iraqi. His actions did prevent further incident and uprising from the other Iraqi men. I verbally counseled PFC [REDACTED] on the proper escalation of force under the ROE and I saw no need for further action. In a mission out brief to the 1/1 CAV chain of command I [REDACTED]

A: The Iraqi guards were verbally and physically resistant during the entire mission. It seemed they felt they were friends to the Americans and that they felt insulted that we would even suspect them of supporting insurgents. Up to the moment we left the facility the men were still yelling at us in Arabic.

Q: After the incident took place, was PFC [REDACTED] separated from the incident or was he allowed to continue with his mission?

A: PFC [REDACTED] was allowed to continue with his mission. There were no further uprisings from the Iraqis.

Q: Would you happen to know the names of the person involved?

A: None of the Iraqi men were actually detained. We held them under security while the compound was searched but we released all of them based on my tactical decision. Because no one was detained or arrested, no names were recorded.

Q: Were there any other incidents after PFC [REDACTED] took control of the situation?

A: We had no further incidents with any of PFC [REDACTED] conduct.

I was the platoon leader for 3rd platoon B 2-325 from APR03 until MAY04. In JUN-JUL03 3rd platoon was attached to 1/1 CAV 1 AD. One mission was to conduct a raid on a compound based on intel that the facility was being used to store and traffic insurgent's weapons. After entering the compound we found 4-5 Iraqi males and at least one AK-47 rifle. The Iraqis were placed under watch of a security detail while the rest of the platoon continued the raid. From a position about 50 meters away I could still hear the Iraqi men and security detail yelling at each other. I yelled over to the guards that no one over there should be talking. A short while after I gave that order I saw PFC [REDACTED] strike one Iraqi who appeared to be trying to stand up. I don't know where any other soldiers were standing when this happened. The Iraqi men were further separated and there were no further incidents. We finished the raid. As we were leaving the Iraqi told my translator that the other Iraqi man was trying to stand because his knee hurt. We did not detain any of the Iraqi men or keep the weapon. Back at the command post I talked to PFC [REDACTED] and his NCO support channel. PFC [REDACTED] told me he saw the man refusing his orders and rising toward him as a threat. I concluded PFC [REDACTED] was reacting to a perceived threat and acted in accordance with the ROE. He used the minimum force needed. Given that the number of Iraqis was greater than the number of guards I felt PFC [REDACTED] used great restraint in not knocking out the Iraqi. His actions did prevent further incident and rising from the other Iraqi men. I verbally counseled PFC [REDACTED] on the proper escalation of force under the ROE and I saw no need for further action. In a mission out brief to the 1/1 CAV chain of command I [REDACTED]

told them what happened on the raid to include the resistance from the Iraqi men and the actions of the soldiers. The chain of command saw it as a finished issue and supported the actions of 3<sup>rd</sup> platoon. No further actions were taken.

Q: During the time the platoon was securing the building, were any of the detainees showing hostility?

A: The Iraqi guards were verbally and physically resistant during the entire mission. It seemed they felt they were friends to the Americans and that they felt insulted that we would even suspect them of supporting insurgents. Up to the moment we left the facility, the men were still yelling at us in Arabic.

Q: After the incident took place, was PFC [REDACTED] reprimanded for the incident or was he allowed to continue with his mission?

A: PFC [REDACTED] was allowed to continue with his mission. There were no further uprisings from the Iraqis.

Q: Would you happen to know one name of the person detained?

A: None of the Iraqi men were actually detained. We held them under security while the compound was searched but we released all of them based on my tactical decision. Because no one was detained or arrested, no names were recorded.

Q: Were there any other incidents after PFC [REDACTED] took control of the situation?

A: We had no further incidents with any of PFC [REDACTED] conduct.

Q: Do you think there was a communication barrier?

A: I think that was the cause of the incident in the first place.

The communication barrier was the sole reason for the incident. The Iraqis did not speak enough English to convey their thoughts, the soldiers to whom PFC [REDACTED] could not comprehend Arabic and the only translator on the mission was located with me the entire time. Only after the [REDACTED]

Incident through the translator did the fact surface that the Iraqi man's knees hurt and he wanted to shift positions. b7C, b7D

Q. Did you think PFC [redacted] acted appropriately?

A. I fully support the actions of PFC [redacted] and applaud his use of restraint in dealing with the Iraqi man. He was one of a few US soldiers tasked with securing a larger group of uncooperative if not hostile Iraqi men. When the man appeared to lunge at PFC [redacted] the soldier's options were to hit him or shoot him dead. Given the infinite number of possible things that could have followed are Iraqi jumping up at a guard I feel that if PFC [redacted] strike to the man did not resolve the issue that at least one or more of the Iraqi men would have died from gun fire from other soldiers. PFC [redacted] felt threatened and he reacted instantly and appropriately. PFC [redacted] did an outstanding job that day and throughout the deployment in OIF.

Then shortly afterwards everyone came back we let the detainees go and we loaded up on trucks and left the compound.

AFTER ABOUT 2 WEEKS OF PATROLING, ROUTE SECURITY AND WEAPONS RAIDS, WE MOVED TO AL-DUWANIYA WHERE WE PICKED UP SECURITY OPERATIONS CONDUCTED PATROLS AND ESTABLISHED NUMEROUS OVERWATCH AND SECURITY POSITION AND TRAFFIC CONTROL POINTS. WE THEN MOVED TO AL RAMADI TO RELIEVE 3<sup>RD</sup> ID FORCES IN SECTOR CONDUCTING SIMILAR OPERATIONS WITH A FOCUS ON CROWD CONTROL AND POLICE SUPPORT.

IN ABOUT MID MAY WE ARRIVED IN BAGHDAD, ONCE IN BAGHDAD WE WERE ASSIGNED TO MAINTAIN SECURITY IN THE AL-DOURA AREA WITH THE COMPANY RECEIVING THE NATIONAL STEEL COMPANY AND AL-DOURA REFINERY AS OUR PRIMARY SECURITY FOCUS. INITIALLY MY UNIT WAS ATTACHED TO 75<sup>TH</sup> REGIMENT IN ARABIA SAUDI ARABIA, THEN AT TEAL WE REMAINED OUR BRIGADE AND DIVISION AND WHEN WE ENTERED BAGHDAD WE CAME UNDER 1<sup>ST</sup> ARMOR DIVISION. AS AN ATTACHMENT OF 1<sup>ST</sup> ARMOR WE WERE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE A PLATOON HANDS TO SUPPORT 1/1 CAV AT CAMP STRIKER NEAR BAGHDAD INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT TO PROVIDE DISMOUNTS FOR DAILY PATROLS AND OPERATIONS.

FOR THIS OPERATION OUR PLANNED ENTRY METHOD WAS A 'KNOCK AND ENTER' WITH SHOTGUN BREACH AS A BACKUP. WE ARRIVED [REDACTED]

1. On order, enemy military and paramilitary forces are declared hostile and may be attacked subject to the following instructions:

- a. Positive Identification (PID) is required prior to engagement. PID is a reasonable certainty that the proposed target is a legitimate military target. If no PID, contact your next higher commander for decision.
- b. Do not engage anyone who has surrendered or is out of battle due to sickness or wounds.
- c. Do not target or strike any of the following except in self-defense to protect yourself, your unit, friendly forces, and designated persons or property under your control:
  - Civilians
  - Hospitals, mosques, churches, shrines, schools, museums, national monuments, and any other historical and cultural sites
- d. Do not fire into civilian populated areas or buildings unless the enemy is using them for military purposes or if necessary for your self-defense. Minimize collateral damage.
- e. Do not target enemy infrastructure (public works, commercial communication facilities, dams), Lines of Communication (roads, highways, tunnels, bridges, railways) and Economic Objects (commercial storage facilities, pipelines) unless necessary for self-defense or if ordered by your commander. If you must fire on these objects to engage a hostile force, disable and disrupt but avoid destruction of these objects, if possible.

2. The use of force, including deadly force, is authorized to protect the following:

- Yourself, your unit, and friendly forces
- Enemy Prisoners of War
- Civilians from crimes that are likely to cause death or serious bodily harm, such as murder or rape
- Designated civilians and/or property, such as personnel of the Red Cross/Crescent, UN, and US/UN supported organizations.

- d. SHOOT: to remove the threat of death/serious bodily injury or to protect designated property. IF YOU MUST FIRE:

- (1) Fire only aimed shots. **NO WARNING SHOTS.**
- (2) Fire no more rounds than necessary.
- (3) Fire with due regard for the safety of innocent bystanders.
- (4) Take reasonable efforts not to destroy property.
- (5) Stop firing as soon as the situation permits.

5. **CROWDS:** Control civilian crowds, mobs, or rioters interfering with US Forces with the minimum necessary force. When circumstances permit, attempt the following steps to control crowds:

- a. Repeated warnings to HALT or "QIF" (pronounced "COUGH").
- b. Show of force, including riot control formation.
- c. Blocking of access, or other reasonable use of force necessary under the circumstances and proportional to the threat.

6. **DETAINEES:** You may stop, detain, search, and disarm persons as required to protect US Forces. Detainees will be turned over to the Military Police or Kuwait Police ASAP.

7. Treat all persons with respect and dignity.
