This investigation was initiated subsequent to receipt of Request for Investigation (RFI) 67C-4, 67E-4 0401-04-CID001, which revealed [REDACTED] Person Under Control (PUC) number [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] PUC number [REDACTED] were abused by U.S. Forces while in custody.

Investigation failed to prove or disprove [REDACTED] was abused as previously alleged, as the Other Coalition Forces, who captured him, could not be interviewed due to their identification not being known based on their operational sensitivity.

About 2010, 3 Aug 04, this office received a Request For Investigation (RFI) 0401-04-CID001, from Headquarters, USACIDC, requesting this office investigate allegations that unknown U.S. Forces struck [REDACTED] on the head with a weapon while in custody in Jalalabad, Afghanistan. Furthermore, the U.S. Forces allegedly caused an injury to the arm of [REDACTED] b7C-4, b6-4 by utilizing tight flexi-cuffs, while in custody at the Khowst Campaign Fire Base, Afghanistan.

About 1020, 5 Aug 04, SA [REDACTED] b7C-1, b6-1 and [REDACTED] b7C-3, b6-3 Category 2 Interpreter, conducted an interview of [REDACTED] who related he was kicked in the legs and back while being detained in Khowst, Afghanistan, by U.S. forces. [REDACTED] further related he had a pre-b7C-4, b6-4 existing injury in his elbow. [REDACTED] translated [REDACTED] verbal statement and SA [REDACTED] b7C-4, b6-4 documented the translation. (See Statement for details)

About 1045, 5 Aug 04, SA [REDACTED] b7C-1, b6-1 obtained a copy [REDACTED] b7C-4, b6-4 detainee packet from the Bagram Collection Point (BCP) facility, Bagram Airfield (BAF), Afghanistan, which documented (13) infractions for spitting on guards, self mutilation and attacking guards on stairways and catwalks while he was escorted to the latrine, all in a two month period of being detained at the facility.

AGENT'S COMMENT: The detainee packet was not included as an exhibit because the documents were classified in nature, and were maintained in the files of this office.

About 1100, 5 Aug 04, SA [REDACTED] b7C-1, b6-1 interviewed SGT [REDACTED] b7C-3, b6-3 NCOIC, Detainee Medical Facility, BCP, BAF, who stated he had not received any complaints from [REDACTED] about abuse or him having any pains. The original medical report of [REDACTED] documented he had nerve damage in his right wrist.

About 0900, 9 Aug 04, SA [REDACTED] b7C-1, b6-1 obtained a copy of [REDACTED] b7C-4, b6-4 detainee packet, which reflected he was released from U.S. custody on 7 Jul 04 to his home province of Khowst, which is currently a high threat area in Afghanistan and was not expected to change in the near future. Further, it was discovered [REDACTED] received a laceration on his head requiring 14 stitches, when he tried to escape upon capture. b7C-4, b6-4

About 0900, 17 Aug 04, SA [REDACTED] b7C-1, b6-1 coordinated with CPT [REDACTED] b7C-3, b6-3 OIC Detainee Operations, BCP, BAF, who provided a document detailing [REDACTED] was released to the BCP facility by Other Coalition Forces (OCF). CPT [REDACTED] further explained the specific OCF members, who captured [REDACTED] could not be determined as the OCF did not provide the relevant information for tracking purposes. b7C-4, b6-4

About 1000, 6 Sep 04, SA [REDACTED] b7C-1, b6-1 interviewed PFC [REDACTED] b7C-3, b6-3, 450<sup>th</sup> MP Company, BAF, who stated she escorted [REDACTED] out of his cell many times and always had problems with him spitting, throwing elbows behind him to hit escort guards, and trying to push her from the staircases.

About 1030, 6 Sep 04, SA [REDACTED] b7C-1, b6-1 interviewed SGT [REDACTED] b7C-3, b6-3, 450<sup>th</sup> MP Company, BAF, who stated he escorted [REDACTED] most of the time due to him being a discipline problem, which was also why [REDACTED] was put into isolation holding. b7C-4, b6-4

About 0700, 17 Sep 04, SA [REDACTED] b7C-1, b6-1 interviewed PFC [REDACTED] b7C-3, b6-3, 58<sup>th</sup> MP Company, BAF, who guarded [REDACTED] at the detainee facility. PFC [REDACTED] stated the one time she had guarded [REDACTED] he urinated in the corner of his cell and took off his surgical mask, and was spitting at the walls and personnel. [REDACTED] was required to wear the mask because he was diagnosed with tuberculosis. b7C-4, b6-4

About 1930, 3 Oct 04, SA [REDACTED] b7C-1, b6-1 interviewed SPC [REDACTED] b7C-3, b6-3 450<sup>th</sup> MP Company, Bagram Airfield, Afghanistan APO AE 09354 (BAF), who stated she guarded [REDACTED] at the BAF detainee facility. SPC [REDACTED] stated the one time out of five she guarded him he was biting on his arms and lips making them bleed to get attention.

About 1950, 3 Oct 04, SA [REDACTED] b7C-1, b6-1 interviewed SPC [REDACTED] b7C-3, b6-3 450<sup>th</sup> MP Company, BAF, who stated he only guarded [REDACTED] when he was initially brought to the BAF detainee facility and he escorted him through the in-processing. SPC [REDACTED] b7C-3, b6-3 further stated [REDACTED] had to be subdued and restrained several times, because he was throwing elbows behind him to hit the escort guards and trying to head butt guards.

About 1130, 25 Oct 04, SA [REDACTED] b7C-1, b6-1 coordinated with COL [REDACTED] b7C-3, b6-3, CJTF-76, SJA, who conducted a legal review of this file and stated there was sufficient evidence to unfound the offenses of Assault and Mistreatment of a Person in U.S. Custody pertaining to [REDACTED] b7C-4, b6-4 [REDACTED] b7C-4, b6-4 due to the fact there was no evidence to prove the allegations and that [REDACTED] b7C-4, b6-4 had an extreme discipline problem the few months he has been in U.S. Custody. COL [REDACTED] b7C-3, b6-3 also concurred that the interview of [REDACTED] b7C-4, b6-4 would be very dangerous due to his Alqida connections and high threat level residence area. b7C-4, b6-4

[REDACTED] STATED HE WAS BLINDFOLDED DURING THE INCIDENT AND DID NOT SEE WHO KICKED HIM. ADDITIONALLY, [REDACTED] STATED THE INJURY TO HIS ARM WAS PRE-EXISTING, AND BEING CUFFED ONLY AGGRAVATED THE INJURY. [REDACTED] STATED HE WANTED U.S. FORCES TO FIX HIS INJURY.

A REVIEW OF [REDACTED] *b7c-4, b6-4* DETAINEE PACKET REVEALED HE HAS HAD 13 DOCUMENTED REPORTS OF DISCIPLINARY INFRACTIONS FOR SPITTING, IGNORING THE GUARDS, SELF MUTILATION, AND TRYING TO INJURE THE GUARDS WHILE ON CATWALKS AND STAIRS.
