SPC **constant** stated that his **b74-5**, **bC-5** intent was to trick the Iraqis into supplying information, that he no intent to harm anyone, never touched anyone and never pointed a weapon at anyone.

CPT SJA, 1st Brigade, 1st Armored Division, stated that command intent is to take action less than court proceedings by providing punishment under Article 15.



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
