The conduct of this investigation determined that SPC

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JABAR was immediately treated by military personal, and transported to the 581st Area Support Medical Company (ASMC), Iraq for initial treatment. SUBJECT: Detainee Death During Escape from Camp Cropper, 12. June 20033

- 1. On 12 Jun 03, two detainees escaped Camp Cropper. They were observed running away from the detainee area by SPC 186th MP Co, who was on exterior guard duty. He fired a total of four rounds at the two escapees, striking one twice (once in the back and once in the legs). The escapee (Ajkel Abedal Hussein Jabar, #7166) died from his wounds.
- 2. CPT MI was appointed as the 15-6 officer and investigated the incident. According to ACI2 and all available records no formal CID ROI was initiated to investigate the incident. CPT Command Judge 64-3,66-3 Advocate, Camp Cropper provided the SJA review/opinion.
