INVESTIGATIVE SUMMARY:

This is an "Operation Iraqi Freedom" Investigation.

This investigation was initiated when the S-3 Sergeant Major, 503rd Military Police Battalion (Mosul, Iraq), reported a detainee in the 2d Brigade detainee holding area died while in U.S. custody.

The investigation established Mr. ABDUL KAREEM was found unresponsive by guards who were conducting a routine morning wake-up call of the detainees. He was last seen alive a few hours earlier when he was provided a blanket by a guard.

There were no signs to indicate abuse or foul play was a factor in his death. A cursory examination of Mr. ABDUL KAREEM by medical and CID personnel did not reveal any clear signs of what may have caused his death. There was no known medical history of Mr. ABDUL KAREEM, nor had he requested medical assistance prior to his death.

The investigation could not determine the cause of death without the benefit of a forensic autopsy. The manner of death is undetermined.

DETAILS

BASIS FOR INVESTIGATION: About 0930, the S-3 SGM, 503rd Military Police Battalion, (Mosul, Iraq) Ft Bragg, NC reported an Iraqi prisoner died while detained at 2nd Brigade Holding Area (BHA), Mosul, Iraq.

b7c-4, b6-4 About 1040, 9 Dec 03, SA [REDACTED] b7c-1, b6-1 coordinated with WO1 [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-4 D Company, 311th Military Intelligence. WO1 [REDACTED] related detainee #58, Mr. Abdureda Lafta ABDUL KAREEM was in placed general population HR #2 and he was not responsive when the other detainees were woke up at 0730. Mr. ABDUL KAREEM was checked for signs of life and no pulse or respiration was apparent and medical assistance was requested. WO1 [REDACTED] stated Mr. ABDUL KAREEM body was moved from the general population HR #2 to Room C where he was examined by medical authorities.

DEATH SCENE EXAMINATION: About 1045, 9 Dec 03, SA [REDACTED] b7c-1, b6-1 and SA [REDACTED] b7c-1, b6-1 conducted a death scene examination of Mr. ABDUL KAREEM. The decedent had been removed from the scene.

Characteristics of the scene: The room was identified as HR #2, a holding area for Iraqi detainees. The room was a brick and mortar type construction, approximately 25 feet long, 18 feet wide, and ten feet high. There were five windows within the room, one located in the north wall and four located in the south wall. There were two Entry/Exit ways (E/E) located within the south wall. The main E/E was located in the south wall, approximately eight inches west of the east wall. The second E/E, which was secured and unused, was located in the south wall, approximately eight inches west of the east wall.

Condition of the scene: There were detainees throughout the room. There was a radio system located in the approximate center of the south wall. Surrounding the radio system, were several boxes of MREs, a heater, and two chairs. There was a pile of blankets located against the east wall, approximately three feet north of the south wall. The room was illuminated by natural light and two light bulbs, affixed to the east and south walls.

Factors pertaining to the E/E: The room could be accessed by two E/Es located in the south wall. The main E/E was located eight inches west of the east wall. There was a metal in construction door within the E/E and appeared to be functional. A second E/E was located eight inches east of the west wall. There was a metal in construction door within the E/E and was secured and unused.

Examination of the body: The decedent, identified as Mr. Abdureda Lafta ABDUL KAREEM, was an older adult male, approximately 65 inches tall, approximately 175 lbs, and was dressed only in

red in color briefs. The decedent had ulcers on both wrists, where he had been bound by flex-i-cuffs. Liver mortis was present throughout the back, with blanching across the shoulders. The decedent had an obvious purple in color birthmark located on his stomach above his navel. The birthmark did not blanch when pressure was applied with a finger. There were no obvious signs of abuse or defensive wounds. A clear fluid was found in the right ear.

Documentation of the scene: SA [REDACTED] b7c-1, b6-1 captured digital images of the death scene and the decedent utilizing a Nikon digital camera system. A death scene sketch was prepared by SA [REDACTED] b7c-1, b6-1 and verified by SA [REDACTED] (See Attached Photos and Sketch)

About 1053, 9 Dec 03, SA [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-1 interviewed Dr (CPT) [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-4 BN Surgeon, 526 FSB, Mosul, Iraq, who rendered a Sworn Statement detailing his actions after being notified of a deceased detainee. (See Sworn Statement for details.)

About 1107, 9 Dec 03, SA [REDACTED] b7c-1, b6-1 interviewed SPC [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-4 B Company, 311th Military Intelligence (MI), Mosul, Iraq, who rendered a Sworn Statement detailing his actions when he realized the detainee was dead. (See Sworn Statement for details.)

About 1115, 9 Dec 03, SA [REDACTED] b7c-1, b6-1 interviewed SGT [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-4 B Battery, 2/44 Air Defense Artillery (ADA), Mosul, Iraq, who rendered a Sworn Statement detailing his actions involving the detainee and his actions upon hearing the detainee was deceased. (See Sworn Statement for details.)

About 1118, 9 Dec 03, SA [REDACTED] b7c-1, b6-1 interviewed PFC [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-4 B Battery, 2/44 Air Defense Artillery (ADA), Mosul, Iraq, who rendered a Sworn Statement detailing his actions upon hearing the detainee was deceased. (See Sworn Statement for details.)

About 1120, 9 Dec 03, SA [REDACTED] b7c-1, b6-1 interviewed of PFC [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-4 B Battery, 2/44th Air Defense Artillery, (Fort Campbell, KY 42223) Mosul, Iraq, who stated he was on guard duty the evening of 8 Dec 03, which began about 2300. PFC [REDACTED] stated prisoner #58, later identified as Mr. Abdureda Lafta ABDUL KAREEM, had been lifting his blind fold and talking excessively. PFC [REDACTED] explained that the prisoners were not permitted to remove their blindfold or talk. PFC [REDACTED] stated Mr. ABDUL KAREEM continued to lift his blindfold, so SGT [REDACTED] bound Mr. b7c-4, b6-4 ABDUL KAREEM hands behind his back, so he could not lift his blindfold. PFC [REDACTED] said about 0100, 9 Dec 03, all the prisoners were put down to sleep. PFC [REDACTED] stated Mr. ABDUL KAREEM was moving around but eventually fell asleep. anything, which led him to believe Mr. ABDUL KAREEM, was suffering or dying. PFC [REDACTED] stated Mr. ABDUL KAREEM had been detained within the facility for about 4 to 6 days and had been a constant talker. PFC [REDACTED] said Mr. ABDUL KAREEM attempted to remove his blindfold frequently and this was not the first time his hands had been bound behind him. b7c-4, b6-4

About 1130, 9 Dec 2003, SA [REDACTED] conducted canvass interviews of SGT [REDACTED] and SGT [REDACTED] both of D Company, 311th Military Intelligence (MI), Mosul, Iraq. SGT [REDACTED] stated he attempted to call the medics but their phone was not working, so he sent SGT [REDACTED] to the battalion aid station to notify medical assistance. SGT [REDACTED] stated he walked to the battalion aid station and requested medical assistance. Upon returning to the Brigade Holding Area, SGT [REDACTED] instructed the guards to move Mr. ABDUL KAREEM to room C. SGT [REDACTED] stated Mr. ABDUL KAREEM was still dressed and flexi cuffed when he was placed in room C. SGT [REDACTED] stated when he interviewed Mr. ABDUL KAREEM on 5 Dec 03 he appeared to be in good health. Mr. ABDUL KAREEM did not disclose any previous medical conditions, medications taken, or medical history during the interview. b7c-1, b6-1 b7c-4, b6-4

SUBJECT: Request for Information (RFI 0212-04-CID001)

1. A review of CID Report of Investigation 0140-03-CID389-61697 reflected it was weak in Thoroughness and Timeliness. The investigation was Timely Reported.
2. There is no documentation in the AIR, Final, or an MFR, explaining the lack of an autopsy. On 10 Dec 03, the ASAC wrote in the AAS: "Battalion & Group ruled no autopsy & the body can be released to the NOK." The Battalion and Group POCs are not identified; nor is why they made this decision. No interrogators were interviewed. The doctor who declared the victim deceased and completed the death certificate was not interviewed. The female medic (NFI) mentioned by SPC [REDACTED] was not identified b7c-4, b6-4 nor interviewed. The Soldier who apprehended the detainee was not interviewed. A statement of one of the guards was in the case file but not included as an exhibit in the ROI. There were no canvass interviews of the other detainees (at least ten of whom are in the crime scene photographs). Additional photographs of the deceased and his clothing on the CD should have been included in the photo packet. The crime scene sketch and the AIR do not document where guard personnel found the deceased. The AIR does not mention the presence, or lack of, signs of a struggle, or of blood or body fluids; nor are the environmental conditions annotated. The records of medical treatment of the deceased were not collected and reviewed. The complainant is identified by position, not by name.
3. All investigative reports were dispatched in a timely manner. Investigation was closed Final on 1 Jan 04.




