About 0940, 21 May 04, SA [REDACTED] and SA [REDACTED] this office, interviewed Mr. [REDACTED] who stated he typed up everything he knew about and witnessed while working in the Temporary Detention Facility at [REDACTED] BIAP, IZ. Mr. [REDACTED] b(6) 8
(7)(c) 8 related he was reporting this conduct because he felt the actions were inhumane even though every harsh interrogation was approved by the J2 of the TF and the medical personnel prior to its execution. He said a guard was reprimanded for giving a hooded detainee a water bottle with urine to drink. Mr. [REDACTED] stated he did not witness the interview but heard about it from the NCOIC he could only identify as [REDACTED]. Mr. [REDACTED] related other harsh techniques, which were used were sleep deprivation, 20-hour interrogation sessions, mopping floors, and also believed the handcuffs, were to tight and caused bruising. Mr. [REDACTED] provided a written location of the facility and also a written description of the layout of the facility. (See statement) b(6) 6

MAY HAVE WITNESSED A DETAINEE ABUSE.

PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATION REVEALED MR. [REDACTED] b(6)(c), b(7)(c)-6
INTERROGATOR, JOINT INTERROGATION DEBRIEFING CENTER (JIDC), 0000010

CAMP SLAYER, IZ, WITNESSED THE USE OF "HARSH" TECHNIQUES, WHILE WORKING IN THE TEMPORARY DETENTION FACILITY AT [REDACTED] b2 b3
[REDACTED], BIAP, IZ. MR. [REDACTED] RELATED HE WAS REPORTING THIS CONDUCT BECAUSE HE FELT THE ACTIONS WERE INHUMANE EVEN THOUGH EVERY "HARSH" INTERROGATION WAS APPROVED BY THE J2 OF THE TASK FORCE AND THE MEDICAL PERSONNEL PRIOR TO ITS EXECUTION. HE SAID A GUARD WAS REPRIMANDED FOR GIVING A HOODED DETAINEE A WATER BOTTLE, WHICH CONTAINED URINE, TO b(6)-6 b(7)(c)-6
DRINK. MR. [REDACTED] STATED HE DID NOT WITNESS THE INCIDENT BUT HEARD ABOUT IT FROM THE NCOIC HE COULD ONLY IDENTIFY AS [REDACTED] MR. [REDACTED] RELATED OTHER HARSH TECHNIQUES, WHICH WERE USED WERE SLEEP DEPRIVATION, 20-HOUR INTERROGATION SESSIONS, MOPPING FLOORS, AND ALSO BELIEVED THE HANDCUFFS WERE TOO TIGHT AND CAUSED BRUISING. MR. [REDACTED] PROVIDED A WRITTEN LOCATION OF THE FACILITY AND ALSO A WRITTEN DESCRIPTION OF THE LAYOUT OF THE FACILITY.

EFFORTS ARE ON-GOING TO LOCATE, FULLY IDENTIFY, AND INTERVIEW THE INDIVIDUALS INVOLVED IN THE TEMPORARY DETENTION FACILITY LOCATED ON CAMP NAMA, BIAP, IZ.

INVESTIGATION CONTINUES BY USACIDC.

7. COMMANDERS ARE REMINDED OF THE PROVISIONS OF AR 600-8-2 PERTAINING TO SUSPENSION OF FAVORABLE PERSONNEL ACTIONS AND AR 380-67 FOR THE SUSPENSION OF SECURITY CLEARANCES OF PERSONS UNDER INVESTIGATION.

1. First investigation involved an elderly lady, Ms. [REDACTED] b(6)-4 b(7)(c)-4 Have you been briefed about her case? If not, I will send you a synopsis of the incident/allegation. If so, could we get a copy of any reports forwarded to you by any other agencies. Also, do you have further information on the victim possibly being paid \$3,600.00? Yes, [REDACTED] b(2) conducted an inquiry that did not substantiate the allegation. Due to the nature of the inquiry, it was not releasable to me. The unit is making a CERP based solatia payment to Ms. [REDACTED] based on property damage and loss of a ring. The [REDACTED] legal advisor is CPT [REDACTED] who is on the "cc" line b(6)-4 b(7)(c)-4
2. Second investigation b(2) involved a detainee and [REDACTED] b(2) detainee related he was abused, while in custody of [REDACTED] b(2) prior to his release to the 1CD DIF. This incident is only now being investigated by BG [REDACTED] b(6)-3 b(7)(c)-3 CG, III Corps b(6)-3 b(7)(c)-3 Artillery. This investigation, appointed by LTG [REDACTED] is more systemic in nature and is to be coordinated with you at all times. BG [REDACTED] legal advisor is MAJ [REDACTED] who is on the "cc" line. b(2) b(6)-3 b(7)(c)-3
3. Third investigation is reference to [REDACTED] b(2) Camp Nama, Baghdad, where an interrogator related he witnessed harsh tactics and possible abuse involving one soldier, who attempted to give a detainee a bottle of urine. Do you have a POC for Camp Nama? This incident is to be investigated by an investigating officer appointed by MG [REDACTED] b(6)-3 I know of no other details than those I forwarded to LTC [REDACTED] b(2) It is my understanding that a CID b(6)-3 investigator who is attached to the parent organization of [REDACTED] b(2) is coming into theater to investigate the incident. b(7)(c)-3 Again, CPT [REDACTED] b(6)-6 b(7)(c)-6 is the POC.
