[redacted] I'm the ASC of ITOS-2. We are responsible for among everything, Iraq. DAD TJ Harrington advised last month that US Army CID had sent a letter in stating that two of our agents in Baghdad were being accused of prisoner abuse. At roughly the same time we received info that the military in Baghdad was being accused of abusing a prisoner that our agents had interviewed and that they, the military, wanted access to our documents regarding the prisoner [redacted]. The 302s we have indicate that SAs [redacted] [redacted] interviewed this particular prisoner. Are these the same agents being accused of abusing a prisoner? If so, should we be giving the military our 302s from the interview? Please advise. [redacted]
