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I subsequently received a very polite phone call from Col requesting that any further inquiry be handled through the HQ channels. In my experience as a former judge advocate in the Marine Corps, the name and rank of an individual who is the subject of a Courts-Martial is not sensitive information. Based on my experience with task force personnel, they are not above manipulating the facts to protect their interests.

Given the present situation with the task force and the issues of detainee abuse under investigation, I doubt the task force will carry this matter any further. I felt, however, it would be prudent to advise you of the situation.
