. FYI, I just received a call from [redacted] an agent in Sacramento, regarding possible misconduct (he called me after trying to reach [redacted] and finding she was on leave). He advised that he recently returned from military deployment in Iraq. While over there, he ran into another FBI employee who was also on a military deployment. This employee ran a detainee facility in Iraq where prisoner abuse occurred. The Sacramento agent was somewhat circumspect over the phone, given the nature of the information, but indicated that the detainee facility was operated "under the radar." He also stated that he had first-hand knowledge regarding the employee's involvement in the abuse, some of which was egregious. He reported this information up his chain of command in DOD, but is uncertain if they are taking any action.
