Just to confirm our conversation and establish for the record: the FBI Agents involved have not been named as subjects in this investigation, nor has there been any allegations against them directly. They are merely listed as witnesses, as they had some sort of contact with the prisoner making the allegations of abuse, at some point during his custody.

As such, we indicated to Army previously that they would be available for interviews, if deemed appropriate by Army CID, and there should be no problem with turning over whatever documentation exists to include their 302s.
