According to [redacted] there are no other guidelines than the "A through X" memo. [redacted] must have been referring to a specific Interrogation Plan (IP) that delineates extraordinary conditions that would allow for special interrogation techniques outside of "A through X". These IPs must be approved by either Mr Rumsfeld or Dr. Wolfowitz. There have been several of these IPs requested that use techniques outside of "A through X" and one or more could have included disrobing of detainees.
